
2. Now the user agency vide its letter No. TRCL/Ravirala-RF/111/FC/91 dated 06.06.2019 again requested for change of name from M/s. Madras Cements Limited to M/s. Ramco Cements Limited. In addition, the user agency vide their letter No. TRCL/R RLM/244/93 dated 06.06.2019 requested for extension of forest clearance No.8-87/1999-FC dated 20.03.2001 for a period of 50 years for instant proposal.

It is, therefore, once again requested to kindly provide all correspondence made for the instant proposal at the earliest for further processing and the State Government may inform the user agency to submit the proposal for change of name of user agency/ Transfer of Forest Clearance from of M/s. Madras Cements Limited to M/s. Ramco Cements Limited in accordance with chapter 5 of Handbook of comprehensive guidelines issued under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 by this Ministry on 28.03.2019. The said Handbook is available on this Ministry's website: www.parivesh.nic.in.

In addition, the State Government may be requested to offer their comments on the representation of user agency for extension of forest clearance No.8-87/1999-FC dated 20.03.2001 for a period of 50 years for instant proposal.
