In this regard, the matter has been examined in the Ministry and it has been decided that the condition no. 2 (i) of Stage-II approval issued vide letter no 8-34/2017-FC dated 10.08.2018 which states that “*Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged*” be read as under:

2 (i). The legal status of the diverted forest land may be changed to revenue land.
