Subject: Proposal for seeking approval of the Central Government under Section 2 (1) (ii) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 for diversion of 11.8259 ha of forest land in favor of National Highways Authority of India, Bikaner for Upgradation to 2 lane with paved shoulder/4 lane of Khajuwala – Poogal Secction (Design chainage 0+000 to 30+812) and Poogal –Dantour-Jaggasar-Gokul-Goddu-Ranjitpura-Charanwala-Naukh-Ba Section of NH-911 (Design Chainage 1+430 to 182+725) (Total length 212.107 Km) under Bharatmala Pariyojana(Proposal No. FP/RJ/Road/41036/2019)

Sir,

Please refer to Government of Rajasthan letter No.1(53)Van2020 dated 09.06.2026 submitted to Sub-Regional Office, Jaipur on the above mentioned subject. In this regard, the proposal submitted by the Government of Rajasthan has been examined in the Ministry. The observations of the Ministry are as follows:-

(i) The rates of NPV were revised by the Central Government w.e.f. 6th January, 2022. Therefore, the State Government is requested to inform the User Agency to deposit the differential amount of NPV in CAMPA account and submit the supporting documents in this regard.

(ii) The State Government shall submit an undertaking by the User agency in compliance of conditions no. 1,5,6,7,10,11,13,14,15,16,17,18,19,20,24,25,26 of Stage-1 approval dated 16.10.2020 as the same is not found to be attached with the compliance report.

In view of the above, it is requested to furnish the above information alongwith supporting documents at the earliest for further examination of the proposal in the Ministry.
