Sub: Change in name of user agency from M/s National Enterprises to M/s Grewal Minerals & Metals LLP in respect of the diverted forest land of 54.399 ha including safety zone of 6.841 ha for Iron Ore Mining accorded vide letter No. 8-10/2015-FC dated 06.10.2020 of Govt. of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, FC Division, New Delhi under Section-2 (1) (ii) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 in favour of San-Indupur Iron & Manganese Ore Mines of M/s National Enterprises in village San-Indupur in Koira Tahasil of Koira Range under Bonai Forest Division of Sundargarh District to M/s Grewal Minerals & Metals L.L.P -regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the State Government's letter no. FE-DIV-FLD-00-0022-2020-11881/FE&CC dated 05.07.2024 on above mentioned subject, seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section 2(1) (ii) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980. In this regard it is informed that the proposal has been examined in the Ministry and following has been observed which is required to be submitted by the State Govt. for further consideration:

- i. This is the case of change in the name of the UA from M/s National Enterprises to M/s Grewal Minerals & Metals LLP. As per the clause 5.1 (v), the proposal has change in the share holding pattern. Therefore. ₹10,000,00/- will be applicable on this case. Therefore, an undertaking from the UA for making the payment of ₹10,000,00/- for change in the name of UA shall be submitted.
- ii. No -objection certificate for such change by the State Government has not been submitted.
- iii. The justification for change in the name of user agency and the circumstances which have necessitated the change shall be elaborated.
- iv. The proposal has been granted Stage-II approval on 06.10.2020. In this regard a report on the compliance duly verified from the concerned Regional Office shall be submitted.

- v. Further, it is also informed that the proposal has been submitted through offline mode. However, for dealing such proposals there is provisions in the PARIVESH 2.0 portal and **Form 'F'** has been designed. In this regard, the instant proposal shall be submitted online on PARIVESH portal.
