Sub: Revised proposal regarding diversion of 5056.5 ha (reduced to 4577.84 ha) of forest land in favour of M/s NHPC Limited for cons0truction od Dibang Multipurpose Project (3000 MW) on Dibang River in Lower Dibang valley district of Arunachal Pradesh.

- 1. This relates to diversion of diversion of 5056.50 ha of forest land in favor of M/s NHPC for construction of Dibang Multipurpose project (3000 MW) on Dibang River in Lower Dibang Valley of Lower Dibang District of Arunachal Pradesh was submitted by the State Government vide their letter no. FOR.10-44/Cons./2003/Vol-I/312-16 dated 18th August 2011
- 2. The Regional Office (North Eastern Zone), Shillong, vide this Ministry's letter dated 14.09.2011 was requested to carry out site inspection of the area proposed for diversion. However, the Regional Office Shillong vide letter dated 1.08.2012 informed the Ministry that due to reasons viz. poor connectivity, remoteness of the area, incessant rainy weather, and scarcity of officers in the Regional Offices, and non-submission of essential information by the State Government viz. complete tree enumeration list, GPS coordinates and suitability of the land identified for CA, site inspection of the area cannot be carried out so far.
- 3. The Regional Office had also informed that as per the details provided in the original proposal, part of the area of the project falls within 10 km radius of the Mehao Wildlife Sanctuary. Taking cognizance of this fact, the project proponent has informed that area falling within 10 km radius has been discarded and requirement of forest land reduced from 5056.50 ha to 5022.842 ha after discarding 33.658 ha of area falling within 10 km radius. However, the Regional Office has ascertained that even after discarding 35.658 ha of area, around 136.902 ha of non-forest land still falls within 10 km radius.
- 4. After receipt of site inspection report from the Regional Office, Shillong, the FAC considered the proposal in its meeting held on 12th July, 2013 and after detailed discussion on the proposal, the Committee recommended rejection of the proposal on the grounds viz. huge forest area with very good forest cover, irreparable and adverse impact on general eco-system of the area by felling of more than 3.5 lakhs of trees, several other HEP have been proposed in the same river valley apart from Dibang HEP, unavailability of study on cumulative impact of all the HEP, etc. The Committee is also of the opinion that ecological, environmental and social costs of diversion of such a vast track of forest land, which is a major source of livelihood of the tribal population of the State, will far outweigh the benefits likely to accrue from the project.
- 5. Subsequently, the proposal, along with the recommendation of the FAC, was also discussed in the meeting held between Secretary, Ministry of Environment and Forests and the Secretary, Ministry of Power on 13.08.2013 and after detailed deliberation on the proposal it was decided that the User Agency shall explore the possibility to reduce the requirement of forest land for the project and a revised proposal may accordingly be submitted to the MoEF for further consideration.
- 6. The State Government of Arunachal Pradesh vide their letter No. FOR.10/Cor./2003/Vol-IV/287 dated 13.02.2014 submitted revised proposal. The facts related to the proposal as contained in the State Government's letter are given below in the form of fact sheet
