Sub: Revocation of In-principal approvals/ Stage-I Clearances issued by this Ministry, New Delhi which are pending due to non compliance of conditions for more than 5 years as provided *under* para 4.2(ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and guidelines thereof.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your kind attention on para 4.2.(i) & (ii) of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 guidelines thereof which states that Two Stage Clearance of Proposals which states that Forestry clearance will be given in two stages. In 1st stage, the proposal shall be agreed to in principle in which usually the conditions relating to transfer, mutation and declaration as RF/PF under the Indian Forest Act, 1927 of equivalent non forest land for compensatory afforestation and funds for raising compensatory afforestation thereof are stipulated and after receipt of compliance report from the State Government in respect of the stipulated conditions, formal approval under the Act shall be issued. However in cases where compliance of conditions stipulated in the in-principle approval is awaited for more than 5 (five) years from the State Governments, the in principle approvals would summarily be revoked.

- 14. It has been observed that there are several cases in your State for which Stage-II Clearances/final approval are pending since five or more years due to non-receipt of compliance on the conditions stipulated in stage-I clearance. A list of such type of cases are enclosed for your ready reference.
- 15. In view of facts stated above it has been decided by the Ministry that Stage I clearance accorded for the above mentioned projects are hereby revoked with immediate effect. If the State Govt. is still interested in the forest clearance in any project then fresh online application with cogent reasons for non-submission of compliance of the condition stipulated in Stage-I Clearance may be submitted for the consideration of the Ministry.
- 16. The State Government /UT may inform whether any non- forestry activity proposed in the proposal referred above, for which Stage I approval was granted, has been undertaken by the user agency. In this regard a report may be furnished within 15 days of issue of this letter.
