With Reference to your above letter I am directed to seek your clarification regarding the payment of various amounts by user agency. As per your letter the user agency has paid following amounts

It is also to be brought to your notice that the as per the condition number 1 the compensatory afforestation is to be raised over non forest land. This condition along with condition number 2 has not been complied with.

You are also requested to direct the user agency to obtain clearance under the provisions of ST&OTFD Act 2006 and submit certificate towards settlement of rights over the proposed forest land as per advisory dated 03.08.2009 by MoEF.

You are therefore kindly requested that complete compliance of the conditions may please be furnished to enable the Ministry grant stage II clearance.
