Sub: FCA, 1980 - Diversion of 1.481 ha of forest land in Nalgonda Division for laying of pipeline and construction of structures in segment -5 for providing safe drinking water under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP Circle, Hyderabad - Furnishing of compliance report - Reg.

I, am directed to invite your attention to the reference 5th cited, in which the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forestry, have accorded approval in-principle (Stage-I) U/s 2 of Forest (C) Act, 1980, for diversion of forest land to an extent of 3.105 ha in erstwhile Warangal (North) Division presently Bhupalpally forest division under Jayashankar-Bhupalpally District - for laying of Pipe Line in Segment-15/6 (Bhupalpally) under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Warangal, subject to fulfillment of certain conditions as stipulated therein.

2. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, in his letter 7th cited, has submitted condition wise compliance report on the conditions stipulated in in-principle (Stage-I) approval. The details of which are as follows:-

The User agency has deposited an amount of Rs.21,61,100/- towards Compensatory Afforestation (CA) and it is the part of Rs.30,88,206/- towards CA scheme into the account of Telangana State CAMPA, New Delhi, Lodhi Complex, with UTR No.IDIBR52018032815988928 Dt:28.03.2018. Same is reflected online at Ministry's portal.
(iv)	The State Government has proposed 1.481 ha. of non-forest land for compensatory afforestation under the subject proposal as part of 187.677 Ha. of non-forest land identified for entire TDWSP projects (Mission Bhageeratha Project). The CA land identified to the extent of 187.677 Ha. for the Mission Bagheeratha Project under the working control of WLM division, Nagarjunasagar shall be apportioned project wise including the CA area identified for the present proposal and all the relevant details like DGPS coordinates, map, soil suitability certificate etc. shall be uploaded in the Ministry's online portal against the subject proposal.	Out of 187.677 ha identified in 3 survey numbers i.e., Peddamunagala (Sy.No.169), Thimmapuram (Sy.No.139 &147)] in Chandampet Mandal of Nalgonda District for CA, under jurisdiction of the FDO, WLM Division, Nagarjunasagar, the non-forest land to an extent of 1.481 ha is earmarked for this project and demarcated with DGPS coordinates for entire area. The co-ordinates, map, CA scheme and soil suitability certificate etc is uploaded in the Ministry's web portal against the subject proposal, duly dividing areas for various projects.
(v)	Identified CA land shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.	The User Agency has agreed and submitted undertaking that the identified CA land and approved CA scheme will not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.

(Cost indicated above). (ix)	Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be paid by the User Agency. (x)	The funds received from the User Agency towards Compensatory Afforestation and Net Present Value under this project shall be deposited in the respective bank account of the Telangana State CAMPA. <u>The User Agency shall compulsorily deposit the CA and other levies only by generating challan through the Ministry's website.</u>	The User agency has generated a challan through the Ministry's website for total amount of Rs.30,88,206/- and deposited an amount of Rs.21,61,100/- towards CA and Rs.9,27,106/- towards Net present into the account of Telangana State CAMPA, New Delhi, Lodhi Complex, with UTR No.IDIBR52018032815988928 Dt:28.03.2018 value under the project FP/TG/WATER/18269/2016. (xi)	Tree standing in the diverted area shall be felled strictly as per requirement with prior permission of the DFO concerned.	The User agency has agreed and submitted Undertaking. Further, the User agency has deposited an amount of Rs.2,219/- (part of Rs.1,77,219/-) towards extraction of tree growth by the forest department with UTR No.IDIBH18087341290 Dt:28.03.2018 into the PD account of DFO, Suryapet.
(xii)	The muck generated in the earth cutting if any, will be disposed off at designated dumping sites and in no case the muck/debris will be disposed off in the forest areas. (xvi)	Minimal disturbance should be ensured by creating labour camps outside the forest area as far as possible and it will be the responsibility of the UA to ensure that the labourers & staff engaged in execution of work do not destruct nearby forest flora & fauna. PCCF (Central) of Regional Office, Chennai may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency.	The User Agency has agreed and submitted undertaking that any other conditions that the Central Government or Addl. PCCF (Central) of Regional Office, Chennai, if any imposed in the interest of Afforestation, Conservation and Management of flora and fauna in the area, will be complied by the user agency.
(xx)	The Progress of the Compensatory afforestation as mentioned by the DFO, Paloncha (presently FDO, Managuru) Division in Sl.No.12(V)(a) (b) of part-II i.e., 55.13 Ha forest land and 2292.817 Ha of non forest land shall be monitored by the Circle Head and a copy of such monitoring report shall be forwarded to the Regional Office to upload the same in the web portal.	The progress of the Compensatory Afforestation will be monitored by the concerned field officers and copy of the monitoring report will be forwarded to the Regional Office, MoEF & CC, Chennai through Nodal Officer for FCA, from time to time besides uploading of the same in web portal.
(xxi)	In the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the user agency is liable for penal action as decided by the Additional PCCF (Central), Regional Office, Chennai.	The User Agency has agreed and submitted undertaking that in event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the user agency is liable for penal action as decided by the Additional PCCF (Central), Regional Office, Chennai.

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3. I am to inform that the stage-I clearance has been published by the User Agency in English and Telugu daily newspapers on **18.09.2018**.

4. I am also to enclose a copy of the letter 7th cited along with its enclosures of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad and to request you to obtain and communicate final (Stage.II) approval, at the earliest.
