5.	The user agency shall submit the copy of approved CAT plan.	Copy of the approved CAT plan is attached	
6.	The State Government would identify the new forest land for compensatory afforestation in view of the area which was found to be rocky and shall be shown physically to the Regional office before submission of the compliance before grant of Stage-II clearance. The Regional Office shall arrange the inspection about new CA area and find out suitability for carrying out compensatory afforestation.	Already the patch, which is rocky has already been replaced.	
7.	Since water is a precious resource, the user agency shall take some measure for creation of water conservation / harvesting structures in the Catchment area so that the water to be released for use of communities and agriculture, downstream, is not affected.	वचन पत्र संलग्न है।

The non forest land identified for raising compensatory afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department before issue of the Stage –II clearance and the said non-forest land as identified for raising compensatory afforestation shall be notified by the State Government as RF under Section-4 or PF under section -20 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 or under the relevant section(s) of the local Forest Act, as the case may be, within the period of 6 months. The Nodal Officer (Forest Conservation) shall report compliance in this regard.	The non-forest land identified for raising compensatory afforestation has been transferred and mutated in favour of State Forest Department. Copy of mutation is attached.	
12.	The user agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory afforestation at the current wages rate in consultation with the State Forest Department in the account of adhoc CAMPA of the concerned State through online portal. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.	An amount of Rs 28.56 Crores, as demanded, has already been deposited in the account of adhoc CAMPA through online portal.	
13.	The user agency shall transfer online, the Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted under this proposal, as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India Dated 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202/1995 and the Guidelines issued by the Ministry vide its letter No. 5-3/2007-FC Dated 05.02.2009. The requisite funds shall be transferred through online portal into ad-hoc CAMPA account of the State concerned.	An amount of Rs 49.45 Crores, as demanded, has already been deposited in the account of adhoc CAMPA through online portal.	
14.	The user agency shall pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The approved Catchment Area Treatment (CAT) plan shall be implemented at the cost of the user agency and commensurate funds shall be deposited through on-line in the account of adhoc CAMPA account.	वचन पत्र संलग्न है।	
15.	The user agency should ensure that the compensatory levies (CA cost, NPV etc.) are deposited through challan generated online on web portal and deposited In appropriate bank online only. The State Government ensure that the user agency shall implement the R&R plan as per the R&R policy of the State Government in consonance with National R&R policy, Government of India before the commencement of the project work. 18.	User agency in consultation with the State Forest department Shall create and maintain. alternate habitat / home for the avifauna, whose nesting tress are to be cleared in this project. Boundary of the forest land proposed to be diverted shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, forward and back bearing, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS co-ordinates.	वचन पत्र संलग्न है।	
20.	State Government shall complete settlement of rights, in terms of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006, if any, on the forest land to be diverted and submit the documentary evidence as prescribed by this Ministry in its letter No, 11-9/1998-FC (pt.) dated 03.08.2009 read with 05.07.2013 in support thereof.	एफ.आर.ए. के तहत प्रमाण पत्र संलग्न है।
