The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years. 	a) The State Government shall charge the "Net Present Value" (NPV) for the 0.61 ha of forest land to be diverted under the proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008 and 09/05/2008 in IA No. 566 in WP (Civil) no. 202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No. 5-1/1998-FC(Pt. II) dated 18/09/2003 as well as letter No. 5-2/2006-FC dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007-FC dated 05.02.2009 in this regards.	An Amount of INR 5,72,790/- has been deposited vide UTR No. INDBR22018021200610783 dated 12/02/2018.
	b) Additional amount of the NPV of diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency, which shall furnish an undertaking to this effect. 5	All the funds received from the User Agency under the project shall be transferred / deposited in CAMPA fund only through e.portal ( <a href="http://forestsclearance.nic.in">http://forestsclearance.nic.in</a> ).	Agreed and uploaded
