The Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, New Delhi vide Ref (1) has accorded 'in-principle' (Stage-I) approval for exploration (G-3) of iron ore resource in 66.91 hectare of forest land in Blocks 13/I (South) of Ramanamalai Block, Ballari District by Geological Survey of India, State Unit Karnataka & Goa, Bengaluru under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to certain conditions. Accordingly, the User Agency and field officers were directed by this office vide Ref (2) to submit the compliance to the conditions of Stage-I approval.

The condition-wise Compliance Report in respect of the conditions stipulated in the 'in-principle' (Stage-I) approval has been received after verification from the field officers Ref (3 & 4). Based on the reports received as above, the condition wise compliance to the conditions of Stage-I approval is as follows.
