Sub:- FCA, 1980 – Diversion of **2.70 Ha** of forest land in Lalgadi Malakpet RF of Hyderabad Division, for formation of road from Aliabad Cross Road to Ghanpur via Medciti Hospital or Medchal (M), in favour of Executive Engineer (PR), Ranga Reddy District, Hyderabad – Compliance report submitted – Regarding.

I, am directed to invite your attention to the reference 3rd cited, and to inform that the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, (RO), Chennai have accorded approval in-principle (Stage-I) U/s 2 of Forest (C) Act, 1980, for diversion of 2.70 Ha of forest land in Lalgadi Malakpet RF of Hyderabad Division, for formation of road from Aliabad Cross Road to Ghanpur via Medciti Hospital of Medchal (M), in favour of Executive Engineer (PR), Ranga Reddy District, Hyderabad, subject to fulfillment of certain conditions as stipulated therein.

2. I am to inform that the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, in her letter 7th cited, has submitted condition wise compliance report on the conditions stipulated in in-principle (Stage-I) approval. The details of which are as follows:-

The construction of culverts/bridges, if any, over the natural streams/rivers/canals, should be done in such a manner that it does not hamper the natural course of water, does not give rise to water-logging, and also does not hamper the movement of wild animals. xii.	There will be speed breaker on the road within the wildlife areas/wildlife crossings, along with frequent signage reminding cross of speed limits and the damage of wildlife hits.	Yes. xiii.	The User Agency shall raise avenue plantations with 1000 numbers of trees on both sides of the proposed road. xv.	Roadside cuttings and fillings which require engineering support shall be provided as per the instructions of the District Forest Officer so as to stabilize the soil. xx.	Any other conditions that the Central Government or Addl. 3. I am to further inform that the User Agency has published the stage-I forest clearance granted by the Govt. of India in two widely circulated daily news papers one in Telugu language in Namasthe Telangana and the other in English language in Hans India on 04-10-2019.

4. I am also to enclose a copy of the letter 7th cited along with its enclosures of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad and to request you to obtain and communicate final (Stage.II) approval, at the earliest.
