I, am directed to invite your attention to the reference 3rd cited, in which the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forestry, have accorded approval in-principle (Stage-I) U/s 2 of Forest (C) Act, 1980, for diversion of forest land to and extent of 3.964 ha of forest land in Kothagudem, Paloncha and Sathupally forest divisions under Kothagudem and Khammam Districts, for laying of Pipe Line of Construction in Segment-25/13 (Ramachandraram) for providing safe drinking water under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Khammam, subject to fulfillment of certain conditions as stipulated therein.

I am to inform that the Government of India vide letter dt.12.07.2017 2. has conveyed Central Government in-principle (Stage.I) approval under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, for diversion of forest land to an extent of 3.964 ha in the following forest divisions, for laying of Pipe Line and Construction of Structures in Segment-25/13 (Ramachandraram) for providing safe drinking water under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Khammam.

3. I am further to inform that the in-principle *(Stage.I)* approval have been communicated to all the concerned officers with instructions to submit condition-wise compliance report in the matter, vide letter dt.31.07.2017.

4. I am also to inform that the District Forest Officers, Bhadradri-Kothagudem & Khammam has obtain compliance of conditions from the User Agency and submitted the condition-wise compliance report together with its enclosures through respective Conservators of Forests i.e., Kothagudem and Khammam respectively, which is received in this office through vide letters dt.22.05.2019 & 29.06.2019.
