Subj: Forest (C) Act - Diversion of forest land to an extent of **3.713 ha** in erstwhile Warangal (South) Division **and presently Mahabubabad forest division** under Mahabubabad District, for laying of Pipe Line in **Segment-17/1 (Nizam Cheruvu)** for providing safe drinking water under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Warangal- Compliance report - Reg.

I, am directed to invite your attention to the reference 3rd cited, in which the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forestry, have accorded approval in-principle (Stage-I) U/s 2 of Forest (C) Act, 1980, for diversion of forest land to an extent of **3.713 ha** in erstwhile Warangal (South) Division **and presently Mahabubabad forest division** under Mahabubabad District, for laying of Pipe Line in **Segment-17/1 (Nizam Cheruvu)** for providing safe drinking water under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Warangal, subject to fulfillment of certain conditions as stipulated therein.

2. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, in his letter 5th cited, has submitted condition wise compliance report on the conditions stipulated in in-principle (Stage-I) approval. The details of which are as follows:-

(iii)	The Compensatory Afforestation (CA) shall be raised and maintained by the State Forest Department over 3.713 ha out of the 187.677 ha of non-forest land identified in Sy.No.169 of Peddamunagala and in Sy.No.139 & 147 of Thimmapuram in Chandampet Mandal of Nalgonda District at the cost of User Agency.	The User Agency has deposited an amount of Rs.54,18,000/- towards CA (part of Rs.77,42,338/-) into the account of Ad-hoc CAMPA account of TS, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi with UTR No. IDIBH18037185155 Dt:06-02-2018, against the project FP/TG/WATER/17178/2015. A copy of the payment is enclosed. Same is reflected online at Ministry's portal.
(iv)	The State Government has proposed 3.713 ha of non forest land for Compensatory Afforestation under the subject proposal as part of 187.677 ha of non forest land identified for entire TDWSP projects (Mission Bageeratha Project). The CA land identified to the extent of 187.677 ha for the Mission Bageeratha project at WLM Division, Nagarjunasagar shall be apportioned project wise including the CA area identified for the present proposal and all the relevant details like DGPS coordinates, amp, CA Scheme, soil suitability certificate etc., shall be uploaded in the Ministry's online portal against the subject proposal.	Out of 187.677 ha identified in 3 survey numbers i.e., Peddamunagala (Sy.No.169), Thimmapuram (Sy.No.139 &147)] in Chandampet Mandal of Nalgonda District for CA, under jurisdiction of the FDO, WLM Division, Nagarjunasagar, the non-forest land to an extent of 3.713 ha is demarcated with DGPS coordinates. The co-ordinates, map, CA scheme and soil suitability certificate etc is uploaded in the Ministry's web portal against the subject proposal.

(vii)	Non-forest land which is transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department for the purpose of compensatory afforestation, shall be declared as Reserve Forest under Section-4 or	The non-forest CA land transferred & mutated in favour of State Forest Department will be declared as PF/ RF under Telangana Forest Act, 1967 within a period of six months upon receipt of Stage II approval.

(viii)	The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value of the diverted forest land measuring 3.713 ha from User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 28.03.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA Nos.826 in 566 with related IA's in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995.	The User Agency has deposited an amount of Rs.23,24,338/- towards NPV (part of amount of Rs.77,42,338/-) into the account of Ad-hoc CAMPA account of TS, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi with UTR No. IDIBH18037185155 dated 06.02.2018, against the project FP/TG/WATER/ 17178/2015. A copy of the payment. Same is reflected online at Ministry's portal.
(ix)	Additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest and if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future, shall be charged by the State Government from User Agency.	The User Agency has agreed and submitted undertaking to pay additional amount of the Net Present Value (NPV) of the diverted forest land if any, becoming due after revision of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in future.
(x)	The funds received from the User Agency towards Compensatory Afforestation and Net Present Value under this project shall be deposited in the respective bank account of the Telangana State CAMPA. <u>The User Agency shall compulsorily deposit the CA and other levies only by generating challan through the Ministry's website.</u>	The User agency has generated a challan through the Ministry's website for an amount of Rs.54,18,000/- towards CA and towards NPV Rs.77,42,338/- (out of total amount of Rs.23,24,338/- deposited) under this project including levies for the forest conservation etc and deposited the same into the account of Ad-hoc CAMPA account of TS,CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi with UTR No. IDIBH18037185155 Dt:06-02-2018, against the project FP/TG/WATER/ 17178/2015. (xi)	Trees standing in the diverted area shall be felled strictly as per requirement with prior permission of the Divisional Forest Officer concerned.	The User Agency has agreed and submitted undertaking for compliance of condition. User Agency has deposited an amount of Rs.16,50,000/- towards extraction of tree growth and details furnished at c.no.(ii).
(xii)	The muck generated in the earth cutting if any, will be disposed off at designated dumping sites and in no case the muck/debris will be disposed off in the forest areas.	The User Agency has agreed and submitted undertaking that muck generated in the earth cutting if any, will be disposed off at designated dumping sites; and in no case the muck/debris will be disposed off in the



(xiv)	The forest land proposed for diversion shall under no circumstances be transferred or subleased to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government	The User Agency has agreed and submitted undertaking that the Forest land proposed for diversion will under no circumstance be transferred to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the central Government.
(xv)	The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.	The User Agency has agreed and submitted undertaking that the Layout plan of the proposal will not be changed without prior approval of the central Government.
(xvi)	Details of list of trees enumerated in the table designated for the same in part II of the online FC application may be uploaded and confirmation in this regard shall be reported along with the compliance report.	Uploaded online
(xvii)	Minimal disturbance should be ensured by creating labour camps outside the forest area as far as possible and it will be the responsibility of the UA to ensure that the labourers & staff engaged in execution of work Dornakal not destruct nearby forest flora and fauna. (xx)	Any other condition that the Central Government or Addl. Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Central) of Regional Office, Chennai may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency. (xxi)	The Progress of the Compensatory Afforestation as mentioned by the District Forest Officer, Warangal in Sl.No.12(v)(b) of part II i.e., 4.916 ha non forest land shall be monitored by the Circle Head and a copy of such monitoring report shall be forwarded to the Regional Office to upload the same in the web portal.	The progress of the Compensatory Afforestation will be monitored by the concerned field officers and copy of the monitoring report will be forwarded to the Regional Office, MoEF & CC, Chennai through Nodal Officer for FCA, from time to time besides uploading of the same in web portal.
(xxii)	In the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the user agency is liable for penal action as decided by the Additional PCCF (Central), Regional Office, Chennai.	The User Agency has agreed and submitted undertaking that in the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the user agency is liable for penal action as decided by the Additional PCCF (Central), Regional Office, Chennai.

3. I am to inform that the stage-I clearance has been published by the User Agency in English and Telugu daily newspapers.
