Sub: Forest (Conservation) Act – Proposal for diversion of **3168.131 ha (revised from 3221.2974 ha)** of forest land in 8 different forest divisions viz. Mahadevpur, Karimnagar-Sircilla, Siddipet, Yadadri, Medak, Nizamabad Banswada and Nirmal divisions for construction of canals, Tunnels, lift system, surge pool, delivery cistern, and reservoirs etc involved in **Kaleshwaram Project** in different districts of Telangana State in favour of Chief Engineer, Kaleshwaram Project under TDWSP - Reg.

I am, directed to invite your attention to the reference 3rd cited, wherein the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Chennai have accorded approval in-principle (Stage-I) for diversion of **3168.131** ha (revised from **3221.2974** ha) of forest land in 8 different forest divisions viz. Mahadevpur, Karimnagar-Sircilla, Siddipet, Yadadri, Medak, Nizamabad Banswada and Nirmal divisions for construction of canals, Tunnels, lift system, surge pool, delivery cistern, and reservoirs etc involved in **Kaleshwaram Project** in different districts of Telangana State in favour of Chief Engineer, Kaleshwaram Project under TDWSP, subject to the fulfillment of certain conditions as stipulated therein.

2. I am to inform that the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad has furnished condition-wise compliance report on the conditions stipulated in in-principle approval (State-I) and the details which are as follows:-

Detailed CA scheme, that was prepared and submitted along with proposals for non-forest CA lands, has been revised for an amount of **Rs. 219,82,64,909/** in compliance to the condition No.xi stipulated, at the current Forest Schedule of Rates/ Standard Schedule of Rates/ Wage Rates/ Market Rates, duly making provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.

Similarly, the CA scheme, that was prepared and submitted along with proposals for degraded forest CA lands in 617.254 Ha in Siddipet and Peddapalle Districts, has also been revised with above specifications.

Similarly, the CA scheme, that was prepared and submitted along with proposals for degraded forest CA lands in 24 Ha in Yadadri District, for loss of Eucalyptus plantations has also been revised with above specifications.

Further to meet the requirements of condition No.xi, CA has been proposed over 2680. 696 ha of degraded forest including 617.254 Ha of degraded forest land submitted with the proposal, giving priority to divisions where the forest is going to be diverted, in addition to the CA over the non-forest CA lands, for amount of **Rs.166,95,41,825/.** The extents of degraded forest lands proposed for CA are as follows:
