DFO, Kalahandi(S) has also certified that the allotted non-forest Govt. land over 5.100 is suitable for bald hill plantation @ 1600 plants/ha. Tahasildar, Thuamul Rampur has also submitted the non-encumbrance and non-encroachment certificate for the allotted non-forest Govt. land. 

Lam directed to say that this Ministry received representations from the Ministries of Mines. Coal and Petroleum and Natural Gas to relax the existing guidelines to exempt drilling of 15-20 bore-holes per sq. km. in torest area for prospecting of minerals from the requirement of obtaining prior approval of the Central Government under the Forest (Conservation) Act. 1980

This Ministry after careful examination of the matter observed that exempting large scale non-forest activities, such as drilling of 15-20 bore-holes/sq. km. for prospecting of minerals in torest areas, from the requirement of obtaining prior approval under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. However, to facilitate expeditious decision on applications seeking prior approval of Central Government under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for prospecting of minerals in forest areas this Ministry, in consultation with the Ministries of Mines, Coal and Petroleum and Natural Gas formulated a simplified format of the application for obtaining prior approval of Central Government under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for propospecting in forest areas. This Ministry has already published in the official Gazette the Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules, 2014 to insert inter-alia the said format as 'Form-C', in Appendix to the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003.

To further simplify the process for grant of approval under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for prospecting of minerals in forest areas, I am directed to say as below:

- (i) Keeping in view that only a small fraction of area located within a prospecting block is utilized for exploration activities, site inspection by concerned Regional Office of this Ministry will be insisted only if the actual area of the forest land proposed to be utilized for construction of new roads/paths and for drilling of bore holes/sample collection pits etc. is more than 100 hectares;
- (ii) As the prospecting operations involve use of forest land for a very short period, area of forest land which is likely to experience temporary change in land use is exempted



(iii) Proposals seeking piror approval under the Forest (Conservation). Act, 1986 for prospecting in forest land are exempted from the requirement of the submission of decimentary evidence in support of settlement of rights in accordance with the procusions of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwollers (Recognition of Forest Rights). Act, 2000 supulated in this Ministry's letter No. 1149–98-FC dated a August 2009.
