An estimate amounting to Rs 21.55 Lacs has been framed to cover the probable cost of Catchment area Treatment (CAT)Plan for Battisa Nalla Minor Irrigation Project, Delder, Tehsil – Aburoad, District-Sirohi .

BRIEF INTRODUCTION OF THE PROJECT:-

Battisa Nalla Minor Irrigation Project,Delder, Tehsil Aburoad, District Sirohi is Proposed on Battisa Nalla which is tributary of West Banas River. The proposed dam site is located near village Delder on Delder –Nichalagaih pucca road Tehsil Aburoad, District Sirohi. Gross and Live Storage Capacity of Proposed Dam are 16.35Mcum and 14.17Mcum. Latitude & Longitude of site are $24^{\circ}30'43.37''$ N & $72^{\circ}52'32.12''$ E respectively. 7.732 Mcum water will be used for drinking purpose in 31 villages and 2 towns of Sirohi district, and 6.438Mcum water will be used to irrigate 900ha in 4Nos of villages of Tehsil Aburoad and Pindwara of Sirohi District.



NECESSITY:-

As per Hand book of Forest (Conservation)Act,1980 and Forest (Conservation)Rules 2003(Amendments made in 2004)In Part-“C” “Application of Forest(Conservation)Act,1980 para4.8. It is stated that “In respect of Minor Irrigation Project, Catchment area treatment plan will not be insisted”.

Since Battisa Nalla Project is a Minor Irrigation Project, the documentary evidence of project being minor irrigation was sought in FAC meeting Dated 28.02.2017 and same was presented and discussed in FAC meeting dated 17.08.2017.

But as per Minutes of meeting of Forest Advisory Committee held on 17th August ,2017 by MoEF New Delhi vide Agenda Note 4 F.No.8-12/2017-FC Dated 17.08.2017 in point No. 3 of first stage clearance of Battisa Nalla Project stated that CAT Plan Shall be insisted in the project ,Which should be submitted before stage II clearance .In view of above requirement of catchment area treatment plan has been prepared for Rs. 21.55 Lacs and submitted for approval:

CATCHMENT AREA TREATMENT (CAT) PLAN :-

Catchment Area is the Watershed of a river basin from where a reservoir receives surface runoff of the rain water through stream, tributaries, and the main rivers itself. The Catchment Area Treatment (CAT) Plan highlights the management techniques to control erosion in the catchment area of a water resources project. The life span of the reservoir is greatly reduced due to silting on account of silt carried by river due to erosion in the catchment area. Adequate preventive measures are thus needed for the treatment of the catchment for the stabilization against future erosion. The Catchment Area Treatment Plan has been formulated with the main objective of arresting erosion in the catchment.

CATCHMENT AREA OF PROJECT :-

The Total catchment area of Battisa Nalla Project is 162.51 Sq. km. i.e 16251.0 Ha, which is free catchment. The affected catchment area 16251.0 Ha, includes submergence area 158.02 Ha, which will not be available for treatment. Hence the net available area for treatment is 16251.0 Ha - 158.02 Ha = 16092.98 Ha.

Out of available area of 16092.98 Ha, 13181.0 Ha has previously been treated by Forest Department from 1991 to 2012 and 2936.83 Ha has been treated in MJSA-I during 2015-2016. Thus the area already treated is 16117.83 Ha. Hence the Catchment Area of Battisa Nalla is already wholly treated. However 15% (i.e. 285 Ha.) of the area of Nichalakhejra (Total area of village=1900 Ha.) treated during 1991-95 by Forest Department, has been taken for retreatment in this plan, being the oldest.

68. The expenditure under the various components of the project budget will be subject to following conditions:
- The payments of salaries to the WDTs/ Secretary of the Watershed Committees etc. would be exclusively charged from the administrative cost component.
 - Savings, if any, in each component of the project cost can be utilised for activity in watershed works only.
 - Purchase of vehicles and other equipments etc., and construction of buildings are not allowed. However, purchase of Computers and related software is permitted.
 - PIAs belonging to Line Departments may preferably outsource to VOs/ CBOs community mobilization and capacity building activities.
69. Unit cost for watershed development of Rs. 6000 per hectare was worked out during April 2001. During 11th Plan it has been suitably revised from Rs. 6000 per ha. to Rs.12,000/ha. in plains and Rs.15,000/ ha in difficult/hilly areas in order to take care of the following three aspects: (a) promotion of livelihoods including improvement of productivity through farming systems, (b) complete coverage of area under the watershed including common/ forest land and (c) general escalation in cost of material as well as minimum wages of labourers.

9.4 Procedure for Release of Installments

70. The central share of funds shall be released to the **SLNA** for three phases of the implementation spread over the period in the following manner or as decided by

the Nodal Ministry.

- The first instalment comprising of preparatory phase activities viz., 20% of the central share will be released straightaway upon the sanction of the project by the SLNA.
- The second instalment comprising of 50% of the central share towards the project cost will be released on proper certification and submission of documents after completion of the preparatory phase and 60% expenditure of the first instalment.
- The third instalment of 30% including 25% of the central share towards the works phase of the project cost and 3% for the consolidation phase will be released on proper certification of expenditure of 75% of the total funds released supported by relevant documents.

However, the existing arrangements for flow of funds by the concerned Ministries may continue if the above mechanism is not feasible.

71. The release of central funds to SLNA will be made directly on the basis of specific proposals received from SLNA. The fund flow pattern will be as follows:
- Project fund relating to Watershed Works, Livelihood and Production System and microenterprises may flow from DoLR to SLNA to WCDC to WC.
 - Administrative Cost, Capacity Building, EPA, DPR, Monitoring component of project funds may flow from DoLR to SLNA to WCDC to PIA.

9.5 User Charges

72. The Gram Sabha through the Watershed Committee (WC) shall put in place mechanism for collecting user charges. No charge will be taken from landless, destitute or disabled / widow headed house holds for work done on private or public land. The user charges collected shall be credited to the WDF for maintenance of assets created during the project.

9.6 Watershed Development Fund

73. One of the mandatory conditions for the selection of villages for watershed projects is people's contribution towards the Watershed Development Fund (WDF). The Contribution of WDF shall be a minimum 10 % of cost of NRM works executed on private land only. However, in case of SC/ST, small and marginal farmers, the minimum contribution shall be 5 % of cost of NRM works executed on their land.

These contributions would be acceptable either in cash at the time of execution of works or voluntary labour. A sum equivalent to the monetary value of the voluntary labour would be transferred from the watershed project account to the WDF bank account that will be distinct from the Watershed Committee (WC) bank account. User charges, sales proceeds and other contributions, disposal amounts of intermediate usufruct rights shall also be deposited in the WDF bank account. Income earned from assets created under the project on common property resources shall also be credited to WDF.

74. For other cost intensive farming system based livelihood activities/interventions such as Aquaculture, Horticulture, Agro-Forestry, Animal Husbandry etc. on

private land directly benefiting the individual farmers, the contribution of farmers will be 20 percent for general category and 10 percent for SC/ST beneficiaries and the project funds will meet the cost of farming system activity to a maximum limit of an amount equal to double of the unit cost of the project for watershed development (i.e. Rs 12,000/15,000 per ha, as the case may be). Farmers' contribution i.e. 20 percent for general category and 10 percent for SC/ST of this amount (i.e. a maximum of Rs 4800/6000 and Rs 2400/3000 as the case may be, respectively for general category and SC/ST beneficiaries) will go to WDF.

Example:

- a) Assuming the total cost of farming system activity/intervention = Rs 30,000
 - Cost of farming system activity to be met from Project fund (@Rs 12,000/ha project unit cost)
 - (General category) = Rs 24,000
 - (SC/ST) = Rs 24,000
 - Farmers' contribution towards WDF
 - (General category, 20% of 24,000) = Rs 4800
 - (SC/ST, 10% of 24,000) = Rs 2400
- b) Assuming the total cost of farming system activity/intervention = Rs 20,000
 - Cost of farming system activity to be met from Project fund (@Rs 12,000/ha project unit cost)
 - (General category) = Rs 20,000
 - (SC/ST) = Rs 20,000
 - Farmers' contribution towards WDF
 - (General category, 20% of 20,000) = Rs 4,000
 - (SC/ST, 10% of 20,000) = Rs 2,000

Farmers' contribution to WDF in such case would be acceptable in cash at the time of execution of works.

75. The Secretary, Watershed Committee (WC) shall maintain a completely separate account of the income and expenditure of the WDF. Rules for operation of the fund should be prepared by the Watershed Committee (WC) and ratified by the Gram Sabha. The WDF bank account should be operated by the President of the Gram Panchayat and any member from the SHG nominated by the Gram Sabha. Alternatively, the guidelines for the management and utilization of the WDF may be evolved by the concerned Nodal Ministry.
76. After completion of Phase II, at least 50% of the WDF funds shall be reserved for maintenance of assets created on community land or for common use under the project. Works taken up on private land shall not be eligible for repair/maintenance out of this Fund. The remaining money may be used as a revolving fund to advance loans to the villagers of the project area who have contributed to the fund. Individuals as well as charitable institutions should be encouraged to contribute generously to this Fund.

9.7 Coordination with Other Schemes / Projects

77. Eleventh Five Year Plan offers an opportunity to converge and harmonise resources of different schemes and programmes specially those under Bharat Nirman and other flagship schemes with watershed development projects. Mandatory preparation of district level plans will be in a position to enable convergence and synergies at the grass-root level. The DPR may elaborate gaps to be filled or watershed activities to be taken up out of BRGF, MGNREGS, artificial ground water recharging, renovation and repairs of tanks, water bodies and any other available sources. Marketing and value addition is also possible



संक्षिप्त प्रतिवेदन

परियोजना परिचय :-

बत्तीसा नाला लघु सिंचाई परियोजना ग्राम देलदर, तहसील आदूरोड के सभीप बत्तीसा नाला पर निर्मित किया जाना प्रस्तावित है। बांध रखल की आदूरोड से दूरी 15 कि.मी. व ज़िला मुख्यालय सिरोही से दूरी 70 कि.मी. है। राज्य सरकार द्वारा परियोजना की प्रशासनिक एवं वित्तीय स्त्रीकृति आदेश क्रमांक F-3(12) AS/1/Cell/96/XVII/120th meeting/ 274 dated 28.07.2016 द्वारा राशि रु. 226.05 करोड़ की जारी गई है। परियोजना का शिलान्यास दिनांक 29.07.2016 को मानीय मुख्यमंत्री महोदय राजस्थान सरकार द्वारा किया गया था।

- प्रस्तावित परियोजना में बांध की कुल भराव क्षमता 677.40 मि.घ.फु. एवं उपयोगी भराव क्षमता 500.40 मि.घ.फु. है। बांध में उपलब्ध पानी ने से 269.80 मि.घ.फु. जल का उपयोग सिरोही ज़िले के 31 गांवों व 2 शहरों को पेयजल सुविधा हेतु तथा शेष पानी को ग्राम देलदर भारत इत्यादि गांवों की 900 हैक्टेयर में सिंचाई सुविधा उपलब्ध कराया जाना प्रस्तावित है। पेयजल हेतु उपलब्ध कराये जाने वाले आरक्षित पानी का समानुपातिक हिस्सा राशि रु. 106.20 करोड़ जन स्वार्थी अभियानिकी विभाग द्वारा पहन की जायेगी।

बत्तीसा नाला लघु सिंचाई परियोजना के निर्माण में दूब क्षेत्र, ऊभ लाइन एवं विस्थापित होने वाली सड़क में कुल 158.32 हैक्टेयर भूमि प्रभावित होती है जिसमें से 91.202 हैक्टेयर भूमि घन विभाग के अधिपत्ता की भूमि हैं तथा राशि 72.03 हैक्टेयर भूमि निजी खातेदारी, आबादी एवं सरकारी विलानाम भूमि है।

पूर्ण भराव क्षमता पर आदूरोड तहसील का क्वारी गांव (ग्राम पंचायत लालदरा) पूर्ण एवं देलदर, जालदरा, नियतागढ़ तीन गांव आरक्षित रूप से दूब क्षेत्र से प्रभावित होंगे। दूब क्षेत्र से विस्थापित होने वाले परिवारों की संख्या 291 हैं, जो सभी अनुशूदीत जनजाति के हैं।

पुनर्वासन एवं पुनर्व्यवस्थापन स्तरों :-

बत्तीसा नाला लघु सिंचाई परियोजना के दूब क्षेत्र में आ रहे सिरोही ज़िले की आदूरोड तहसील के 4 गांव की भूमि प्रभावित होगी तथा दो गांव के लिए एवं नियतागढ़ के 291 परिवार प्रभावित होंगे जिनका पुनर्वासन पुनर्वासन किया जायेगा। पुनर्वासन एवं पुनर्व्यवस्थापन हेतु भूमि राजस्थान द्वारा आवंटित की जाएगी।

मुआवजा :-

राज्य सरकार द्वारा आदेश क्रमांक 74/भू.अ./ज.सं/2015/5672-5678 दिनांक 26.09.2016 द्वारा धारा-7 के अन्तर्गत सामाजिक समायात निधारण अध्ययन के मूलानुसार हेतु द्वुशाखीद विशेषज्ञ समूह का गठन किया गया तथा आदेश क्रमांक/160/भू.अ./ज.सं/2016/6845-47 दिनांक 13.12.2016 द्वारा धारा-6 के अन्तर्गत सामाजिक समूह के निर्दिष्ट रूप आनुमोदन किया गया।

अधिनियम की धारा-11 के अन्तर्गत राज्य सरकार द्वारा क्रमांक 160/भू.अ./ज.सं/2016/ 6872 दिनांक 14.12.2016 को विज्ञाप्ति जारी कर उपलब्ध अधिकारी, आबूपर्यंत द्वी प्रशासक नियुक्त किया गया तथा धारा-11 के प्रकाशन की तिथि 26.12.2016 से 60 दिवस की अधिधि में किसी हितवद्व व्यक्ति द्वारा आपत्ति प्रत्युत नहीं किये जाने से भूमि अवाप्ति अधिकारी एवं उपचुन्ड अधिकारी, आदूरपर्त द्वारा धारा-15 की कार्यवाही दिनांक 05.06.2017 को पूर्ण गत धारा-16 की कार्यवाही प्राप्तमा की गई।

पुनर्वासन एवं पुनर्व्यवस्थापन स्कीम :-

अधिनियम की धारा-43 के अन्तर्गत राज्य सरकार द्वारा अधिसूचना क्रमांक 150/भूआ./ज.स./2016/7083 दिनांक 28.12.2016 जारी की गई तथा धारा-45 के अन्तर्गत पुनर्वासन एवं पुनर्व्यवस्थापन समिति को गठन आदेश क्रमांक 150/भूआ./ज.स./2016/646-650 दिनांक 08.02.2017 द्वारा किया गया।

पुनर्वासन एवं पुनर्व्यवस्थान स्कीम तैयार करने हेतु दूब क्षेत्र की भूमि, परिवारों एवं परिसम्पत्तियों की गणना हेतु फील्ड सर्वेक्षण किया गया। फील्ड सर्वेक्षण से प्राप्त गणना के आधार पर प्रालय पुनर्वासन एवं पुनर्व्यवस्थापन स्कीम तैयार की गई।

प्रालय पुनर्वासन एवं पुनर्व्यवस्थान स्कीम की जन सुनवाई संबंधित ग्राम सभाओं में दिनांक 29.06.2017 को की गई द्वारा प्राप्त पुनर्वासन एवं पुनर्व्यवस्थान स्कीम का अनुमोदन किया तथा परिवारों व परिसम्पत्तियों का पुनः सर्वेक्षण या पुनर्व्यवस्थापन क्षेत्र को लेकर कुछ आपत्तियां प्रस्तुत की।

प्राप्त आपत्तियों की पालना में दिनांक 01.06.2017 से 07.06.2017 को दूब क्षेत्र के परिवारों व परिसम्पत्तियों की पुनः गणना की गई तथा गणना/सर्वेक्षण से प्राप्त आंकड़ों का समावेश कर प्रालय पुनर्वासन एवं पुनर्व्यवस्थान स्कीम तैयार की गई है।

S.O. 1533 Whereas, a draft notification under sub-rule (3) of Rule 5 of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 for imposing certain restrictions and prohibitions on new projects or activities, or on the expansion or modernization of existing projects or activities based on their potential environmental impacts as indicated in the Schedule to the notification, being undertaken in any part of India¹, unless prior environmental clearance has been accorded in accordance with the objectives of National Environment Policy as approved by the Union Cabinet on 18th May, 2006 and the procedure specified in the notification, by the Central Government or the State or Union territory Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), to be constituted by the Central Government in consultation with the State Government or the Union territory Administration concerned under sub-section (3) of section 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 for the purpose of this notification, was published in the Gazette of India Extraordinary, Part II, section 3, sub-section (ii) vide number S.O. 1324 (E) dated the 15th September, 2005 inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby within a period of sixty days from the date on which copies of Gazette containing the said notification were made available to the public;

And whereas, copies of the said notification were made available to the public on 15th September, 2005;

And whereas, all objections and suggestions received in response to the above mentioned draft notification have been duly considered by the Central Government;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) and clause (v) of sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, read with clause (d) of sub-rule (3) of rule 5 of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986 and in supersession of the notification number S.O. 60 (E) dated the 27th January, 1994, except in respect of things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby directs that on and from the date of its publication the required construction of new projects or activities or the expansion or modernization of existing projects or activities listed in the Schedule to this notification entailing capacity addition with change in process and/or technology shall be undertaken in any part of India only after the prior environmental clearance from the Central Government or as the case may be, by the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority, duly constituted by the Central Government under sub-section (2) of section 3 of the said Act, in accordance with the procedure specified hereinafter in this notification.

2. Requirements of prior Environmental Clearance (EC):- The following projects or activities shall require prior environmental clearance from the concerned regulatory authority, which shall hereinafter referred to be as the Central Government in the Ministry of Environment and Forests for matters falling under Category 'A' in the Schedule and at State level the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA) for matters falling under Category 'B' in the said Schedule, before any construction work, or preparation of land by the project management except for securing the land, is started on the project or activity:

- (i) All new projects or activities listed in the Schedule to this notification;
- (ii) Expansion and modernization of existing projects or activities listed in the Schedule to this notification with addition of capacity beyond the limits specified for the concerned sector, that is, projects or activities which cross the threshold limits given in the Schedule, after expansion or modernization;
- (iii) Any change in product - mix in an existing manufacturing unit included in Schedule beyond the specified range.

3. State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority:- (1) A State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority hereinafter referred to as the SEIAA shall be constituted by the Central Government under sub-section (3) of section 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 comprising of three Members including a Chairman and a Member - Secretary to be nominated by the State Government or the Union territory Administration concerned.

- (2) The Member-Secretary shall be a serving officer of the concerned State Government or Union territory administration familiar with environmental laws.
- (3) The other two Members shall be either a professional or expert fulfilling the eligibility criteria given in Appendix VI to this notification.
- (4) One of the specified Members in sub-paragraph (3) above who is an expert in the Environmental Impact Assessment process shall be the Chairman of the SEIAA.
- (5) The State Government or Union territory Administration shall forward the names of the Members and the Chairman referred in sub- paragraph 3 to 4 above to the Central Government and the Central Government shall constitute the SEIAA as an authority for the purposes of this notification within thirty days of the date of receipt of the names.
- (6) The non-official Member and the Chairman shall have a fixed term of three years (from the date of the publication of the notification by the Central Government constituting the authority).
- (7) All decisions of the SEIAA shall be unanimous and taken in a meeting.

4. Categorization of projects and activities:-

- (i) All projects and activities are broadly categorized in to two categories - Category A and Category B, based on the spatial extent of potential impacts and potential impacts on human health and natural and man made resources.

(ii) All projects or activities included as Category 'A' in the Schedule, including expansion and modernization of existing projects or activities and change in product mix, shall require prior environmental clearance from the Central Government in the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF) on the recommendations of an Expert Appraisal Committee (EAC) to be constituted by the Central Government for the purposes of this notification;

(iii) All projects or activities included as Category 'B' in the Schedule, including expansion and modernization of existing projects or activities as specified in sub paragraph (ii) of paragraph 2, or change in product mix as specified in sub paragraph (iii) of paragraph 2, but excluding those which fulfill the General Conditions (GC) stipulated in the Schedule, will require prior environmental clearance from the State/Union territory Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA). The SEIAA shall base its decision on the recommendations of a State or Union territory level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) as to be constituted for in this notification. In the absence of a duly constituted SEIAA or SEAC, a Category 'B' project shall be treated as a Category 'A' project;

5. Screening, Scoping and Appraisal Committees:-

The same Expert Appraisal Committees (EACs) at the Central Government and SEACs (hereinafter referred to as the (EAC) and (SEAC) at the State or the Union territory level shall screen, scope and appraise projects or activities in Category 'A' and Category 'B' respectively. EAC and SEAC's shall meet at least once every month.

(a) The composition of the EAC shall be as given in Appendix VI. The SEAC at the State or the Union territory level shall be constituted by the Central Government in consultation with the concerned State Government or the Union territory Administration with identical composition;

(b) The Central Government may, with the prior concurrence of the concerned State Governments or the Union territory Administrations, constitutes one SEAC for more than one State or Union territory for reasons of administrative convenience and cost;


(c) The EAC and SEAC shall be reconstituted after every three years;

(d) The authorised members of the EAC and SEAC, concerned, may inspect any site(s) connected with the project or activity in respect of which the prior environmental clearance is sought, for the purposes of screening or scoping or appraisal, with prior notice of at least seven days to the applicant, who shall provide necessary facilities for the inspection;

(e) The EAC and SEACs shall function on the principle of collective responsibility. The Chairperson shall endeavour to reach a consensus in each case, and if consensus cannot be reached, the view of the majority shall prevail.

6. Application for Prior Environmental Clearance (EC):-

An application seeking prior environmental clearance in all cases shall be made in the prescribed Form I annexed herewith and Supplementary Form IA, if applicable, as given in Appendix II, after the identification of prospective site(s) for the project and/or activities to which the application relates, before commencing any construction activity, or preparation of land, at the site by the applicant. The applicant shall furnish, along with the application, a copy of the pre-feasibility project report except that, in case of construction projects or activities (item 8 of the Schedule) in addition to Form I and the Supplementary Form IA, a copy of the conceptual plan shall be provided, instead of the pre-feasibility report.

7. Stages in the Prior Environmental Clearance (EC) Process for New Projects:-

7(i). The environmental clearance process for new projects will comprise of a maximum of four stages, all of which may not apply to particular cases as set forth below in this notification. These four stages in sequential order are:-

- Stage (1) Screening (Only for Category 'B' projects and activities)
- Stage (2) Scoping
- Stage (3) Public Consultation
- Stage (4) Appraisal

I. Stage (1) - Screening

In case of Category 'B' projects or activities, this stage will entail the scrutiny of an application seeking prior environmental clearance made in Form I by the concerned State-level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) for determining whether or not the project or activity requires further environmental studies for preparation of an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) for its appraisal prior to the grant of environmental clearance depending upon the nature and location specificity of the project. The projects requiring an Environmental Impact Assessment report shall be termed Category 'B1' and remaining projects shall be termed Category 'B2' and will not require an Environment Impact Assessment report. For categorization of projects into B1 or B2 except item 8 (b), the Ministry of Environment and Forests shall issue appropriate guidelines from time to time.

II. Stage (2) - Scoping

(i) "Scoping": refers to the process by which the Expert Appraisal Committee in the case of Category 'A' projects or activities, and State level Expert Appraisal Committee in the case of Category 'B1' projects or activities, including applications for expansion and/or modernization and/or change in product mix of existing projects or activities, determine detailed and comprehensive Terms Of Reference (TOR) addressing all relevant environmental concerns for the preparation of an Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) Report in respect of the project or activity for which prior environmental clearance is sought. The Expert Appraisal Committee or State level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned shall determine the Terms of Reference on the basis of the information furnished in the prescribed application Form I/Form 1A including Terms of Reference proposed by the applicant, a site visit by a sub-group of Expert Appraisal Committee or State level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned only if considered necessary by the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned. Terms of Reference suggested by the applicant if furnished and other information that may be available with the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned. All projects and activities listed as Category 'B' in item 8 of the Schedule (Construction/Township/Commercial Complexes/Housing) shall not require Scoping and will be appraised on the basis of Form I/ Form 1A and the conceptual plan.

(ii) The Terms of Reference (TOR) shall be conveyed to the applicant by the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee as concerned within sixty days of the receipt of Form I. In the case of Category A Hydroelectric projects Item 1(c) (i) of the Schedule the Terms of Reference shall be conveyed along with the clearance for pre-construction activities. If the Terms of Reference are not finalized and conveyed to the applicant within sixty days of the receipt of Form I, the Terms of Reference suggested by the applicant shall be deemed as the final Terms of Reference approved for the EIA studies. The approved Terms of

Reference shall be displayed on the website of the Ministry of Environment and Forests and the concerned State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority.

(iii) Applications for prior environmental clearance may be rejected by the regulatory authority concerned on the recommendation of the EAC or SEAC concerned at this stage itself. In case of such rejection, the decision together with reasons for the same shall be communicated to the applicant in writing within sixty days of the receipt of the application.

III. Stage (3) - Public Consultation:

(i) "Public Consultation" refers to the process by which the concerns of local affected persons and others who have plausible stake in the environmental impacts of the project or activity are ascertained with a view to taking into account all the material concerns in the project or activity design as appropriate. All Category 'A' and Category 'B1' projects or activities shall undertake Public Consultation, except the following:-

- (a) modernization of irrigation projects (item 1(c) (ii) of the Schedule).
- (b) all projects or activities located within industrial estates or parks (item 7(c) of the Schedule) approved by the concerned authorities, and which are not disallowed in such approvals.
- (c) expansion of Roads and Highways (item 7 (f) of the Schedule) which do not involve any further acquisition of land.
- (d) all Building /Construction projects/Area Development projects and Townships (item 8).
- (e) all Category 'B2' projects and activities.
- (f) all projects or activities concerning national defence and security or involving other strategic considerations as determined by the Central Government.


(ii) The Public Consultation shall ordinarily have two components comprising of:-

(a) a public hearing at the site or in its close proximity- district wise, to be carried out in the manner prescribed in Appendix IV, for ascertaining concerns of local affected persons;

(b) obtain responses in writing from other concerned persons having a plausible stake in the environmental aspects of the project or activity.

(iii) the public hearing at, or in close proximity to, the site(s) in all cases shall be conducted by the State Pollution Control Board (SPCB) or the Union territory Pollution Control Committee (UTPCC) concerned in the specified manner and forward the proceedings to the regulatory authority concerned within 45(forty five) of a request to the effect from the applicant.

(iv) in case the State Pollution Control Board or the Union territory Pollution Control Committee concerned does not undertake and complete the public hearing within the specified period, and/or does not convey the proceedings of the public hearing within the prescribed period

directly to the regulatory authority concerned as above, the regulatory authority shall engage another public agency or authority which is not subordinate to the regulatory authority, to complete the process within a further period of forty five days.

(v) If the public agency or authority nominated under the sub paragraph (iii) above reports to the regulatory authority concerned that owing to the local situation, it is not possible to conduct the public hearing in a manner which will enable the views of the concerned local persons to be freely expressed, it shall report the facts in detail to the concerned regulatory authority, which may, after due consideration of the report and other reliable information that it may have, decide that the public consultation in the case need not include the public hearing.

(vi) For obtaining responses in writing from other concerned persons having a plausible stake in the environmental aspects of the project or activity, the concerned regulatory authority and the State Pollution Control Board (SPCB) or the Union territory Pollution Control Committee (UTPCC) shall invite responses from such concerned persons by placing on their website the Summary EIA report prepared in the format given in Appendix IIIA by the applicant along with a copy of the application in the prescribed form, within seven days of the receipt of a written request for arranging the public hearing. Confidential information including non-disclosable or legally privileged information involving Intellectual Property Right, source specified in the application shall not be placed on the web site. The regulatory authority concerned may also use other appropriate media for ensuring wide publicity about the project or activity. The regulatory authority shall, however, make available on a written request from any concerned person the Draft EIA report for inspection at a notified place during normal office hours till the date of the public hearing. All the responses received as part of this public consultation process shall be forwarded to the applicant through the quickest available means.

(vii) After completion of the public consultation, the applicant shall address all the material environmental concerns expressed during this process, and make appropriate changes in the draft EIA and EMP. The final EIA report, so prepared, shall be submitted by the applicant to the concerned regulatory authority for appraisal. The applicant may alternatively submit a supplementary report to draft EIA and EMP addressing all the concerns expressed during the public consultation.

IV. Stage (4) - Appraisal:

(i) Appraisal means the detailed scrutiny by the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee of the application and other documents like the Final EIA report, outcome of the public consultations including public hearing proceedings, submitted by the applicant to the regulatory authority concerned for grant of environmental clearance. This appraisal shall be made by Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned in a transparent manner in a proceeding to which the applicant shall be invited for furnishing necessary clarifications in person or through an authorized representative. On conclusion of this proceeding, the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned shall make categorical recommendations to the regulatory authority concerned either for grant of prior environmental clearance on stipulated terms and conditions, or rejection of the application for prior environmental clearance, together with reasons for the same.

(ii) The appraisal of all projects or activities which are not required to undergo public consultation, or submit an Environment Impact Assessment report, shall be carried out on the basis of the prescribed application Form I and Form IA as applicable, any other relevant

validated information available and the site visit wherever the same is considered as necessary by the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned.

(iii) The appraisal of an application be shall be completed by the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned within sixty days of the receipt of the final Environment Impact Assessment report and other documents or the receipt of Form I and Form I-A, where public consultation is not necessary and the recommendations of the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee shall be placed before the competent authority for a final decision within the next fifteen days .The prescribed procedure for appraisal is given in Appendix V.;

7(ii). Prior Environmental Clearance (EC) process for Expansion or Modernization or Change of product mix in existing projects.

All applications seeking prior environmental clearance for expansion with increase in the production capacity beyond the capacity for which prior environmental clearance has been granted under this notification or with increase in either lease area or production capacity in the case of mining projects or for the modernization of an existing unit with increase in the total production capacity beyond the threshold limit prescribed in the Schedule to this notification through change in process and or technology or involving a change in the product -mix shall be made in Form I and they shall be considered by the concerned Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee within sixty days, who will decide on the due diligence necessary including preparation of EIA and public consultations and the application shall be appraised accordingly for grant of environmental clearance.

8.Grant or Rejection of Prior Environmental Clearance (EC):

(i) The regulatory authority shall consider the recommendations of the EAC or SEAC concerned and convey its decision to the applicant within forty five days of the receipt of the recommendations of the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned or in other words within one hundred and five days of the receipt of the final Environment Impact Assessment Report, and where Environment Impact Assessment is not required, within one hundred and five days of the receipt of the complete application with requisite documents, except as provided below.

(ii) The regulatory authority shall normally accept the recommendations of the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned. In cases where it disagrees with the recommendations of the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned, the regulatory authority shall request reconsideration by the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned within forty five days of the receipt of the recommendations of the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned while stating the reasons for the disagreement. An intimation of this decision shall be simultaneously conveyed to the applicant. The Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned, in turn, shall consider the observations of the regulatory authority and furnish its views on the same within a further period of sixty days. The decision of the regulatory authority after considering the views of the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned shall be final and conveyed to the applicant by the regulatory authority concerned within the next thirty days.

(iii) In the event that the decision of the regulatory authority is not communicated to the applicant within the period specified in sub-paragraphs (i) or (ii) above, as applicable, the


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applicant may proceed as if the environment clearance sought for has been granted or denied by the regulatory authority in terms of the final recommendations of the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned.

(iv) On expiry of the period specified for decision by the regulatory authority under paragraph (i) and (ii) above, as applicable, the decision of the regulatory authority, and the final recommendations of the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned shall be public documents.

(v) Clearances from other regulatory bodies or authorities shall not be required prior to receipt of applications for prior environmental clearance of projects or activities, or screening, or scoping, or appraisal, or decision by the regulatory authority concerned, unless any of these is sequentially dependent on such clearance either due to a requirement of law, or for necessary technical reasons.

(vi) Deliberate concealment and/or submission of false or misleading information or data which is material to screening or scoping or appraisal or decision on the application shall make the application liable for rejection, and cancellation of prior environmental clearance granted on that basis. Rejection of an application or cancellation of a prior environmental clearance already granted, on such ground, shall be decided by the regulatory authority, after giving a personal hearing to the applicant, and following the principles of natural justice.

9. Validity of Environmental Clearance (EC):

The "Validity of Environmental Clearance" is meant the period from which a prior environmental clearance is granted by the regulatory authority, or may be presumed by the applicant to have been granted under sub paragraph (iv) of paragraph 7 above, to the start of production operations by the project or activity, or completion of all construction operations in case of construction projects (item 8 of the Schedule), to which the application for prior environmental clearance refers. The prior environmental clearance granted for a project or activity shall be valid for a period of ten years in the case of River Valley projects (item 1(c) of the Schedule), project life as estimated by Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee subject to a maximum of thirty years for mining projects and five years in the case of all other projects and activities. However, in the case of Area Development projects and Townships [item 8(b)], the validity period shall be limited only to such activities as may be the responsibility of the applicant as a developer. This period of validity may be extended by the regulatory authority concerned by a maximum period of five years provided an application is made to the regulatory authority by the applicant within the validity period, together with an updated Form 1, and Supplementary Form 1A, for Construction projects or activities (item 8 of the Schedule). In this regard the regulatory authority may also consult the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee as the case may be,

10. Post Environmental Clearance Monitoring:

(i) It shall be mandatory for the project management to submit half-yearly compliance reports in respect of the stipulated prior environmental clearance terms and conditions in hard and soft copies to the regulatory authority concerned, on 1st June and 1st December of each calendar year.

(ii) All such compliance reports submitted by the project management shall be public documents. Copies of the same shall be given to any person on application to the concerned regulatory authority. The latest such compliance report shall also be displayed on the web site of the concerned regulatory authority.

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11. Transferability of Environmental Clearance (EC):

A prior environmental clearance granted for a specific project or activity to an applicant may be transferred during its validity to another legal person entitled to undertake the project or activity on application by the transferor, or by the transferee with a written "no objection" by the transferor, to, and by the regulatory authority concerned, on the same terms and conditions under which the prior environmental clearance was initially granted, and for the same validity period. No reference to the Expert Appraisal Committee or State Level Expert Appraisal Committee concerned is necessary in such cases.

12. Operation of EIA Notification, 1994, till disposal of pending cases:

From the date of final publication of this notification the Environment Impact Assessment (EIA) notification number S.O.60 (I) dated 27th January, 1994 is hereby superseded, except in suppression of the things done or omitted to be done before such suppression to the extent that in case of all or some types of applications made for prior environmental clearance and pending on the date of final publication of this notification, the Central Government may relax any one or all provisions of this notification except the list of the projects or activities requiring prior environmental clearance in Schedule I, or continue operation of some or all provisions of the said notification, for a period not exceeding one year from the date of issue of this notification.
