I, am directed to invite your attention to the reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited and to inform that the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forestry, have accorded approval in-principle (Stage-I) U/s 2 of Forest (C) Act, 1980, for diversion of 22.258 Ha of forest land in Warangal (N) Division (13.965 ha RF + 2.583 ha ESZ) and WLM Division Warangal (5.710 ha) for laying of Pipe Line and construction of structures in Segment-20/3 (Eturunagaram) for providing safe drinking water to Warangal District under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Warangal, subject to fulfillment of certain conditions as stipulated therein.

2. I am to further inform that the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, in her letter 6<sup>th</sup> cited, has submitted condition wise compliance report on the conditions stipulated in in-principle (Stage-I) approval. The details of which are as follows:-
