I, am to invite your attention to the reference 3rd cited and to inform that the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, R.O.(South Eastern Zone) Chennai have accorded approval in-principle (Stage-I) U/s 2 of Forest (C) Act, 1980, for diversion of forest land to an extent Diversion of forest land to an extent of 4.660 ha(4.41 Ha in Khammam & 0.246 Ha in Paloncha) Division for laying of Pipeline and Construction of structures in Segment-25/14 (Balarajugutta) for providing safe drinking water under Telangana Drinking Water Supply Project in favour of Superintending Engineer, TDWSP (RWS&S) Circle, Khammam, subject to fulfillment of certain conditions as stipulated therein.

2. I am to further inform that the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, in her letter 5th cited, has submitted condition wise compliance report on the conditions stipulated in in-principle (Stage-I) approval. The details of which are as follows:-

(iii) The Compensatory Afforestation (CA) shall be raised and maintained by the State Forest Department over **4.66** out of the 145.18 ha of non-forest land identified in sy.no.100 of Nagilla Village at Madgul Mandal in Amangal Range of Amangal Division at the cost of user agency. The User Agency has deposited an amount of Rs.79,40,470/- towards C.A. Scheme into the account of TELANGANA STATE CAMPA, New Delhi, Lodhi Complex, in A/c No.6432456786 with UTR No.IDIBH 18127405102 Dated 07-05-2018 against the project proposal **No.FP/TG/WATER/18949/2016**

(iv) Identified CA land and approved CA scheme shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government. The User Agency has agreed to comply with the condition and submitted an undertaking, which is enclosed herewith.

(v) The CA area identified at Amangal Division which is apportioned project wise shall be treated as per the CA scheme approved. The Non forest land to an extent of 145.18 Ha. has been identified in Sy.No.100 of Nagilla (V) at Madgul Mandal in Amangal Range of Amangal Division apportioned project wise including the CA Area identified for the present proposal all relevant details to that extent undertaking is enclosed herewith.

(vi) Non-Forest land identified for raising compensatory afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department before issue of the Stage-II clearance. The non-forest land identified by the UA, for raising compensatory afforestation has been transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department.

(vii) Non-Forest land which is transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department for the purpose of compensatory afforestation, shall be declared as Reserved Forest under Section-4 or Protected Forest under Section The non-forest CA land transferred & mutated in favour of State Forest Department will be declared as PF/ RF under Telangana Forest Act, 1967 within a period of six months upon receipt of Stage-II approval.

3. I am to inform that the stage-I clearance has been published by the User Agency in Telugu daily newspapers on **19-12-2018**.

4. I am to further inform that the GoI vide Ir.dt.18.06.2020 have requested to furnish the additional information on all segments of Telangana Drinking Water Supply Projects in a prescribed proforma, for which Stage-I approval has been accorded by the Regional Office. Accordingly, this office vide PCCF Lr.dt.12.01.2021 has called for the above information on all segments, Now, the CF, Kothagudem vide Ir.dt.23.09.2021 has submitted the additional information in the prescribed proforma, the additional

information as sought by GOI received is enclosed as **Annexure-I**. In addition to the above, this office has also sought some additional information, which is also enclosed as **Annexure-II**.

5. I am also to enclose a copy of the letter 5th cited along with its enclosures of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad and to request you to obtain and communicate final (Stage.II) approval, at the earliest.
