I, am to invite your attention to the reference 7th cited and to inform that the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, (IRO), Hyderabad have accorded approval in-principle (Stage-I) U/s 2 of Forest (C) Act, 1980, for diversion of **0.6228 ha** of forest land for laying approach road to the proposed Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) treatment and disposal facility of GHMC at Nallavelly(V), Nallavelly RF, Sangareddy Dist., in favour of Superintending Engineer (SWM), GHMC, Hyderabad, subject to fulfilment of certain conditions as stipulated therein.

2. I am to further inform that the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, in his letter 9th cited, has submitted condition wise compliance report on the conditions stipulated in in-principle (Stage-I) approval. The details of which are as follows:-

The Stage-I approvals has been published in the Hindu on 10.12.2022 in English and Namaste Telangana on 10.12.2022 and details of letters addressed to local bodies to the displaying the notice boards.

Further, the User Agency vide Lr.No. dated.13.12.2022 has requested for according working permission.

Further, with regard to issue of working permission, it is informed that as per the clarification issued in ref 3rd cited on the applicability of the Forest(Conservation) Rules, 2002 issued in ref 2nd cited that "provisions of Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003 shall apply to the proposals submitted online through Parivesh Portal and which have been accepted by the Nodal Officer before 28.06.2022". In the instant case the proposals have already been accepted by the Nodal Officer/ Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF) and the Stage-I approval has been granted. Hence, the guidelines issued in ref 1st cited in the form of Handbook and amendments issued therein and issued till that time are applicable.

At Para 11.2 of the Handbook issued by the Ministry in F.No.5-2/2017- FC, Dt.28.03.2019, and amendments issued therein and the guidelines issued in F.No.11-306/2014-FC (pt), Dt.28.08.2015, detailed procedure about grant of permission for tree cutting and commencement of work of a linear project in forest land (such as laying of new roads, widening of existing highways, transmission lines, water supply lines, optic fiber cabling, railway lines etc., in which the in-principle approval under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 is accorded), for a period of one year is given, to facilitate speedy execution of projects. Such orders shall be passed only after full realization of funds for compensatory Afforestation, Net Present Value (NPV), wildlife conservation plan, plantation of dwarf species of medicinal plants, and all such other compensatory levies, specified in the Stage I (in-principle) approval from the UA, and where ever applicable, transfer and mutation of non-forest/ revenue forest land in favour of State Forest Department.

Further, the State Government vide Memo No.3983/For.I(1)/2016-2,Dt.15.10.2016 has authorized the Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests & Head of Forest Force to issue working permission to the User Agency for tree cutting and commencement of work of linear projects, for a period of one year, subject to the conditions stipulated in the in-principle approval and their compliance, which is in accordance with the guidelines issued by Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change, Government of

India in F.No.11-306/2014 -FC(pt.), dt.28.08.2015.

in exercise of the powers delegated to the undersigned by the State Government & with reference to Handbook of F(C) Act, 1980, F(C)Rules, 2003, Guidelines & Clarifications in F.No.5-2/2017-FC, Dt.28.03.2019 and F.No.11-306/2014-FC(pt.), Dt.28.08.2015 and amendments issued therein issued by Ministry of Environment and Forests & Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Government of India, and **working permission is hereby accorded** in favour of the Regional Officer, MORTH, Hyderabad, for **tree cutting / translocation of trees and commencement of work** in the forest land proposed to be diverted from the date of entering into agreement with the District Forest Officer, Nirmal District for a period upto **one year**, **subject to the following conditions:**

1. The Regional Officer, MORTH, Hyderabad **i.e., User Agency** shall report to the District Forest Officer, Nirmal and obtain further permission from him before starting the work and works should be carried out under the supervision of the DFO.
2. The User Agency shall publish the working permission now granted in verbatim language along with the conditions and safe-guards imposed by the Central Government in Stage-I approval in two widely circulated daily newspapers, one in vernacular language and the other in English language, so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the project proponent for use of forest land for non-forest purposes. (C.No.vii of F.No.11-306/2014-FC(pt) dt: 28.08.2015).
3. The Regional Officer, MORTH, Hyderabad shall enter into an agreement with the District Forest Officer, Nirmal agreeing to perform all conditions as stipulated in Stage-I approval orders as per the para 11.2 of guidelines of the Hand book issued by the Gol, MoEF& CC, New Delhi on 28.03.2019 on F(C)Act, 1980, F(C)Rules, 2003, Guidelines & Clarifications as well as covering letters, Part II/III/IV of Forest Department, inspection note and obtain further permission from the concerned **District Forest Officer's** for commencement of the works.
4. The copies of the Forest Clearance and working permission should also be submitted to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal Bodies by the Second Party in addition to the relevant offices of the Government who in turn has to display the same in 30 days. (C.No. vii of F.No. 11-306/2014 - FC(pt) dt: 28.08.2015).
5. The Forest Department shall dispose all the appeals filed against the order of Deemed Permission issued by the PCCF(HoFF). (C.No.v & vi of F.No.11-306/2014 - FC(pt) dt: 28.08.2015).
6. The User Agency shall agree, bind and undertake to comply any other conditions that may be imposed from time to time by the MoEF&CC, Gol, State Government and PCCF in the interest of conservation, protection & development of forests.
7. The working permission issued is valid **upto one year** from the date of issue of further permission by the concerned District Forest Officer. If the User Agency fails to comply with the conditions stipulated in Stage-I approval within stipulated time, for further extension they should approach MoEF&CC, Gol.
8. The User Agency shall agree, bind and declare that the forest department shall

fell all standing trees / translocate trees, if any in the forest area being diverted for the project by the forest department itself and the user agency shall undertake not to touch or fell such trees in any manner.

9. The works should be carried out without any scope for violations under various rules and guidelines envisaged under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 and other relevant guidelines and Rules in force.

10. Any other conditions imposed by the concerned District Forest Officer/Chief Conservator of Forests during execution of work in the interest of protection of Forests shall be carried out at the project cost.

The District Forest Officer, Nirmal is requested to enter into agreement with User Agency for working permission and permitted to take up construction of boundary pillars / translocation of trees from the amount deposited in the CA-PD account of DFO/FDO soon after entering into agreement for working permission. The works shall be included in APO **2022-23** for CA-PD account and should be reported in MPR of CA-PD account.

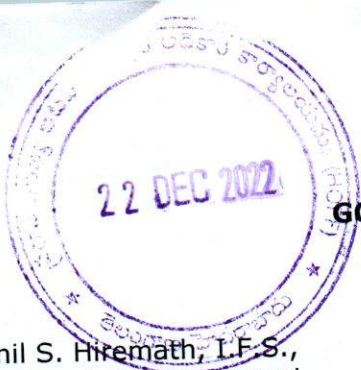



Ready to thrill fans: Indian Racing League in-charge

Hyderabad is all set to host the season finale of Indian Racing League as India's first street race returns to the city after two weeks for a weekend showdown.

Along the picturesque Necklace Road on the banks of the Hussainsagar with the iconic Buddha statue at the backdrop, drivers arrived in jumpsuits to get a feel of the circuit with the race organisers carrying out final inspection ahead of the first qualifying race on Saturday.

The season opener that was held in the city on November 19-20 was called off due to technical failure and a host of logistical issues. However, chairman of RPPL Akhilesh Reddy, the man in charge of the race, is confident of hosting a successful one.

"Firstly, I want to clarify that Formula E and Indian Racing League are not the same and there was a lot of confusion despite clarifications. In the first event, there were a couple of flaws as we could not get the gate closures as planned and we had to do a lot of things at the last minute. But, this time we are well equipped and are confident of hosting a successful one," Mr. Reddy told The Hindu in an exclusive chat at the race paddock.

Chaotic scenes were witnessed at the inaugural as many fans could not witness it despite having valid tickets as there was a communication breakdown between the organisers and the officials.

Acknowledging the lapses, Mr. Reddy said, "There were too many invitees as the street circuit was happening for the first time in India. We miscalculated the turnout and there was no bifurcation between ticket buyers and invitees, which made things hectic and it was a case of over-capacity."

"But this time, we have

bifurcated invitees, ticket-holders and VVIP guests. We have made separate arenas and they are going to stick to their designated enclosures. We will make sure there is no trespassing and we have increased the security in order to keep the race more organised this time," he added.

Pandemonium reigned inside the race track also during the opener as the lack of foot-over-bridges (FOBs) forced fans to cross the race track and navigate adjacent to the pit lane section on their way to the designated seating arena. But, this time, the authorities have installed FOBs and cordoned off the race track, keeping it strictly off-limits to the general public.

"We have constructed three FOBs so that people don't have to cross the track. Since the FOBs were not in place last time, we had to stop the race and then allow people inside. This time, there won't be any such issues," he said.

From a fresh coat of paint to a robust tyre wall and flashy pit lane exit lights, the 2.8 km stretch with 17 twists is ready to test drivers and thrill fans when the lights go green.
