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I wish to inform that, the User Agency ie. The Divisional Engineer, Highways, Nagapattinam has uploaded the Compliance report for the conditions stipulated by the Government of India in Stage-I approval for diversion of 0.53 ha in Pudupattinam RF Bit-I for the reconstruction of existing damaged bridge at KM 18/4 of Puthur-Pudupattinam Palaiyur road of Nagapattinam District.

The above Compliance Report has been verified and forwarded by the Wildlife Warden, Nagapattinam and the Chief Conservator of Forests, Trichy vide reference 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> cited above.
