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'Kim, Putin summit to discuss arms deal'

Kremlin declines to confirm North Korean dictator's visit

WASHINGTON

A United States official said on Monday that North Korean leader Kim Jong Un may travel to Russia soon to meet with President Vladimir Putin as the Kremlin tries to acquire military equipment for use in its war in Ukraine.

The official, who spoke to AP on condition of anonymity, said the US expects Kim will make the trip within the month. The official said the US isn't sure exactly where or when the meeting would take place, but the Pacific port city of Vladivostok would be a likely possibility given its relative proximity to North Korea.

National Security Council spokeswoman Adrienne Watson noted on Monday that Russian Defence Minister Sergei Shoigu travelled to Pyongyang recently and had tried to persuade N Korea to sell artillery ammunition to Russia.

Shoigu, who in July visited North Ko-

rea, on Monday said Moscow was considering joint military drills with North Korea. "Why not? They are our neighbours," Shoigu was quoted as saying by the TASS news agency, when asked about the possible exercises.

Watson said, "We have information that Kim Jong Un expects these discussions to continue, to include leader-level diplomatic engagement in Russia." She added that the US is urging North Korea "to cease its arms negotiations with Russia and abide by the public commitments that Pyongyang has made to not provide or sell arms to Russia."

Shoigu said on Monday that the two countries may hold joint war games. The New York Times first reported that Kim planned to meet with Putin in Russia this month. However, the Kremlin on Tuesday declined to confirm a possible summit between Putin and Kim Jong Un.

Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) has granted Environmental Clearance (EC) vide File No: J-12011/12/2021-IA.1 (R)(EC Identification Number: EC23A0501AP5311226N) issued date: 27.08.2023 to New and Renewable Energy Development Corporation of Andhra Pradesh Ltd (NREDCAP) for "Chitrawathi (Open loop) Pumped Storage Hydro-Electric Project (500 MW) in an area of 136 ha at Village Peddakotta, Tehsil Tadimari, Sri Satyaha Sal District, Andhra Pradesh".

The salient features of 500 MW Chitrawathi Pump Storage project are stated as under:

Proposed capacity: 500 MW (2 x 250 MW)

Project Description: The Chitrawathi Pumped Storage Project will comprise of two reservoirs. The existing Chitrawathi balancing reservoir will be the lower reservoir and a new reservoir to be constructed on the hilltop with embankment of maximum height 57.3 m to create the desired storage capacity and used cyclically for energy storage and discharge. Evaporation losses, if any will be recouped periodically.

Land Requirement: For the development of Chitrawathi PSR land would be required for construction of project components, reservoir area, muck dumping, construction camps and colony, etc. Total land required for the construction of proposed activities is approximately 136 ha.

Water: This Project envisages non-consumptive re-utilization of 0.216 TMC of water for recirculation among these two reservoirs.

Compliance: The stipulated conditions notified by Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Government of India and State Pollution Control Board (SPCB) will be strictly complied with every six months in respect of environmental safety standards and the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) will be informed along with the compliance report.

The estimated project cost is INR 2,406.42 crore. Total capital cost earmarked towards environmental pollution control measures is INR 19.23 crore and the Recurring cost (operation and maintenance) will be about INR 5.5 lakhs per annum. Total Employment will be 500 personnel. Industry proposes to allocate INR 2.0 crore towards CER.

- In the event of failure to comply with any of the above conditions the User Agency is liable for penal action as per the rules / guidelines issued under FCA, 1980;
- The State Government shall process and submit compliance report on the above conditions through online (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>).

After receipt of the compliance report on above mentioned conditions, the proposal will be considered for final approval. This in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of 5 years from the date of issue of this letter. In the event of non-compliance of the above conditions, this in-principle will be revoked.

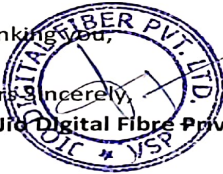
