Kind attention is invited to the reference (i) cited wherein, it was informed that the Govt. of India, MoEF&CC, Vijayawada has conveyed In-principle (Stage-I) approval under Section-2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for Diversion of 45.19 Ha towards the subject stretch in favour of Project Director, NHAI, PIU-Tirupati subjected to certain conditions.

- 2. Further, DFO also requested to submit the compliance report on the conditions stipulated by the Govt. of India in the Stage-I (In-Principle) approval as said above.

After receipt of the compliance report on above mentioned conditions, the proposal will be considered for final approval. This in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of 5 years from the date of issue of this letter.
