In the reference 2nd cited, the Divisional Forest Officer, Chintur while enclosing a comparative statement showing the details of difference 1.056 Ha, had requested to furnish condition wise compliance to the Stage 1 permission for taking up further process.. The compliance is submitted as detailed below:

Condition no. (ix) – The user agency / State Government shall ensure to include entire stretch of forest area required for diversion in future cases especially linear projects and fresh proposal for left out area over 0.110 Km (from Km.202+890 to Km.203+000) (in Thantilanka Extn –I RF of Kunavaram range shall be submitted, if required for the project; and for prior approval under FCA, 1980.

Reply: As per the comparative statement, the area of diversion of 1.05 Ha doesn't pertain to the left over 110 m along but it combines from other three reaches also. A detailed pictorial representation of stretches mentioned in the statement along with explanation on the necessity of further diversion is submitted hereunder. As per the explanation submitted, a part of additional length i.e., from Km.202+890 to Km.202+982 = 0.092 Km out of 0.110 Km. was already considered in the diversion proposal in continuation reach from Bandierevu RF, submitted for the subject work in 2018. In the remaining 0.110 – 0.092 = 0.018 km length the alignment was adjusted with in the available right of way and as such no more diversion is required in this stretch. The same thing was submitted earlier also.

Condition no. (x) – The difference area of 1.056 Ha which is claimed to be not covered neither in the earlier proposal nor in RoW admitted of forest area diverted in the different stretches in three RFs i.e., Madhavaraopeta RF, Bandirevu RF & Pegha RF shall be dealt by the State Government as appropriate as per the provisions made under Indian Forest Act, 1972 and other State Acts dealing with the conservation of Forests by the State Government.

Reply: The area of 1.056 Ha comprises in three stretches as given in comparative satement as detailed below. A pictorial representation enclosed is self-explanatory. However the details are given below:

- 1) Stretch from Km.192+827 to Km.196+865: In this reach an additional area of 0.038 Ha is shown to be the difference required for a length of 38 meters. (Even sought diversion for a width of 10 mts in this balance stretch of 38 mts which works out to be 0.038 Ha)
 - It is submitted that 10 mts RoW from Madhavaraopeta RF to Bandirevu RF was already allowed as per the notification and admitted by the DFO, Chintur i.e., from Km.192+850 to Km.196+850 (4.00 Km). In the current proposal diversion for additional width was only shown to be diverted. In as much as the RoW of 10 mt was already admitted, additional width for widening for the entire length of 4.038 Km was already approved, there is no necessity of additional area of 0.038 Ha for a length of 38 meters as mentioned in the comparative statement.
- 2) Stretch from Km.198+148 to Km.202+982 (4.834 Km): In this reach an additional area of 0.144 Ha (0.052 +0.092 = 0.144 Km x 10 mts = 0.144 Ha) is shown to be the difference required to be diverted
 - The reach from Km.198+148 to Km.198+200 (0.052 Km) where in the alignment of the highway was realigned towards left side (for curve improvement) totally deviating from the existing carriageway for diversion of average width of 32 meters as reported by the DFO, Chinturu vide Rc.No.583/2017/C4 dated 23.02.2022 (Copy enclosed). Hence there is no necessity of diverting this bit of 0.052 Km
 - The reach from Km.202+890 to 202+982 (0.092 Km) was already diverted in Thantilanka Extn-1RF for a width of 10 meters in 2012 and widening on both sides was proposed in 2018 proposal and approved for diversion. Hence, there is no necessity of the additional area as shown in comparative statement.
- 3) Stretch from Km.207+240 to Km.211+824 (4.584 Km): In this reach an additional area of 0.874 Ha (0.874 Km x 10 m = 0.874 Ha) is shown to be the difference required to be diverted.

The reach from Km.207+240 to Km.208+120 (0.880 Km) is a Government land (Revenue land) located in Sy.no.26 to 30 of Edugurallapalli village of Chinturu mandal in which Rythu Bharosa Kendra (RBK) and Grama Sachivalayam buildings etc., are existing. Since this is a non-forest land no diversion proposals were also authenticated in 2012. But, for widening this bit of 0.880 Km forest diversion was proposed in 2018 and the same was also authenticated.

In view of the position of land as revenue land, there is no necessity of diversion of 0.874 Ha for the existing width of the road.

4) Stretch from Km.202+890 to Km.203+000 (0.110 Km): In this reach an additional length of 0.110 Km is shown to be still proposed for diversion in widening portion.

The reach from Km.202+890 to Km.202+982 (0.092 Km) was diverted for widening in continuation of Bandirevu RF (more detailed under Sl.No.2). Our alignment has been adjusted to be in the available RoW in the remaining length of 0.018 Km i.e. from Km.202+982 to Km.203+000. Therefore, there is no necessity of new widening proposal for the additional length of 0.110 Km as sought for.

In view of the above circumstance, additional area of 1.056 Ha and additional length of 110 meters are not required and the pictorial representation submitted is self-explanatory which is submitted here with triplicate for favour of information and taking further necessary action.



Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P., Guntur in the reference 2nd cited, has requested to submit the following additional information on Diversion of 25.31 ha of Forest land for Upgradation of existing NH-30 from Km.169.770 to 236.150 of Vijayawada to Jagadalpur section to two lane with paved shoulders in the State of Andhra Pradesh in favour of EE (R&B) NH Division, Kakinada. The replies are submitted herein the following.

1) Legal status of the existing road i.e., whether the existing road is a notified ROW or any prior approval accorded by the Central Government under FCA, 1980 etc. and supporting documents like ROW notification with clearly indicating actual length & width of Row and copy of the approval order under FCA, 1980 as the case may be to be furnished.

The Executive Engineer, NH Division, Visakhapatnam has submitted proposal for diversion of Forest land 25.31 ha. in three different stretches i.e., i) Section.1:- From Km 192/827 to Km 196/865 in Madhavaraopeta RF ii) Section.2:- From Km 198/148 to Km 202/982 Bandirevu RF iii) Section.3:- From KM 207/240 to Km 211/824 Pegha RF for upgradation of existing NH-30 Vijayawada to Jagadalpur section in Chintur Forest Division areas. The details of RoW allowed in the Gazette notification is tabulated as below:-

In this regard it is submitted that, the existing road was widened from 3.66 mtrs. single lane BT carriageway to 7.00 mtrs. two lane BT carriageway and the total formation width including BT surface is 10.00 mtrs. The width of the existing BT carrying way is 7 mtrs. Only. 4) The proposed financial outlay i.e., Rs 152.277 lakhs to carry out Compensatory Afforestration over 51.05 Ha. degraded forest area including 10 years of maintenance is appears to be not sufficient. Hence, State Forest Department may re-examine the CA scheme and revised site specific CA scheme shall be furnished.

The earlier submitted C.A Scheme is re-examined and revised site specific CA Scheme including 10 years maintenance with an out lay of Rs 602.356 Lakh is prepared and submitted herewith.

Further it is submitted that, the total length of the road passing through the Chintur Forest Division from Bhadrachalam to Chatti Village proposed for widening is 66.38 Kms. The Executive Engineer, NH Division, Visakhapatnam has submitted proposal for diversion of Forest land in three stretches only. The area of stretches between Bit-I, Bit-II & Bit-III and along the entire road is having good vegetation and where ever tree growth is there, is not included in the diversion proposal even though the area between the stretches are deemed to be Forest as per Andhra Pradesh Forest Act, 1967 and the Supreme Court directions.

As per the Hon'ble supreme court judgement/ order dt: 12.12.1996 in WP(C) No.202/95 with WP(C) No.171/96 T.N.Godavaraman Thirumalapad Vs Union of India, the word 'Forest' must be understood according to its dictionary meaning. This description covers all statutory recognized forests, whether designated as reserved, protected or otherwise for the purpose of section 2(1) of the Forest Conservation Act. The term forest land, occurring in section 2, will not only include Forest as understood in the dictionary sense, but also any area recorded as forest in the Government record irrespective of the ownership. This is how it has to be understood for the purpose of section 2 of the Act. The provisions enacted in the forest conservation Act, 1980 for the conservation of forests and the matters connected therewith must apply clearly to all forests so understood irrespective of the ownership or classification thereof.

Further it is also submitted that, As per G.O.Ms.No.816, Forests and Rural Development (For-III) Dt.25.11.1978 published in A.P.Gazette R.S. Pt.1, Dt.04.01.1979, all lands in scheduled areas containing trees, shrubs and coppice growth shall be forest.

The trees existing in the proposed road project including the stretches between the RF areas is also enumerated, but the area is not incorporated for diversion. Forest tree species like Tectona grandis, Soymida febrifuga, Terminalia alata, Tamarandus indica, Butea monosperma, Madhuca indica, Syzygium etc., are present. A total number of 5148 nos. are enumerated during year 2018 in the entire stretch.

Further, the User Agency has not included for diversion of forest area from Km 202/89 to Km 203/0 a length of 0.110 Kms. in Thatilanka Extn.RF, where there is a right of way to a width of 8 mts.

In view of the above it is submitted that, the User Agency has submitted proposals for diversion of Forest Land in three stretches by not taking the count of the area having the tree growth in between the stretches along the Road passing in Chintur Division Forest area and the area in the stretch from Km 202/89 to Km 203/0 a length of 0.110 Kms. in Thatilanka Extn.RF. It is also mandatory to include such entire area which is having tree growth for diversion under Section (2) of F(C) Act, 1980 for any development activity.

Hence, I request the Chief Conservator of Forests, Rajahmundry Circle, Rajamahendravaram to kindly take necessary action to bring the facts to the kind notice of the Prl.Chief Conservator of Forests, A.P., Guntur for taking further action in this matter.
