The project proposal asking amendment of the EC for "Drilling of 45 Exploratory wells in upper Assam Shelf (South) Area encompassing Jorhat and Golaghat District, Assam" proposed by Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited (ONGC) is placed before the SEAC held on 21/01/2023 for appraisal and detail deliberation.
