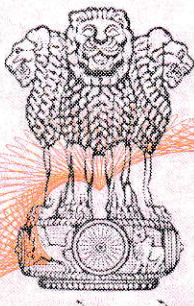

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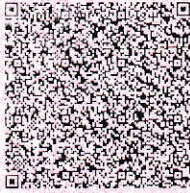

10. Oil India Limited hereby undertakes that the layout plan of the mining plan/ proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
11. Oil India Limited hereby undertakes that OIL shall not expand its occupation or use surrounding forest/forest land in any manner otherwise expressed in this clearance.
12. Oil India Limited hereby undertakes that land so diverted shall revert back to the Forest Department in case it is not needed for the above use after due restoration to its original status (as far as possible and to the satisfaction of State Forest Department).
13. Oil India Limited hereby undertakes that OIL shall return the proposed 0.21 ha temporary accommodation area after 120 days to State Forest Department and apply for change in land use in case of successful exploratory discovery as per F(C) Act, 1980 rules and guideline.
14. Oil India Limited hereby undertakes that the permission for exploratory drilling or prospection would not ipso facto imply any commitment on the part of Central Govt for diversion of forest land even if minerals/oil/hydrocarbons are struck for mining.

18. Oil India Limited hereby undertakes that OIL shall undertake mining in a phase manner after taking due care for reclamation of the mined over area. The concurrent reclamation plan as per the approved mining plan shall be executed by the user agency from the very first year, and an annual report on implementation thereof shall be submitted to the Nodal Officer, Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, in the concerned State Govt and the concerned Integrated Regional Office of the Ministry. If it is found from the annual report that the activities indicated in the concurrent reclamation plan area not being executed by the user agency, the Nodal Officer or the concerned Integrated Regional Office may direct that the mining activities shall remain suspended till such time, reclamation activities are satisfactorily executed.
19. Oil India Limited hereby undertakes that OIL shall submit the annual self -compliance report in respect of the above stated conditions to the State Government, concerned Integrated Regional Office and to this Ministry by the end of March every year; and
20. Oil India Limited hereby undertakes that violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action may be taken as prescribed in para 1.21 of Chapter 1 of the Handbook of comprehensive guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as issued by this Ministry's letter No. 5-2/2017-Fc dated 28.03.2019.
21. Oil India Limited hereby undertakes that OIL shall comply all the provisions of all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, Hon'ble Court Order(s) and NGT Order(s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF&CC), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF&CC issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA, for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 5.6 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of **OIL INDIA LIMITED, DULIAJAN** for Exploratory Drilling in Karbi Anglong District falls within the Dhansiri Reserve Forest near Daldali in Diphu tehsil.

It is further certified that

a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 5.6 hectares of forest land proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultation and meetings of the Forest Right Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as Annexure I to Annexure II.

b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest-dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA.

c) The each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/processes under the FRA have been carried out and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and the details of proposed diversion.

d) The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present.

e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under Section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it.

f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specially safeguarded as per Section 3(2) of the FRA.

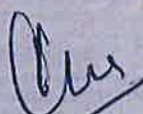

2.2 Specific Conservation Plan for OIL's Project in AA-ONN-2010/2 Block:

The Conservation Plan is prepared for the project with the objective to mitigate the Human-Elephant conflict management and conservation of the Indian Elephants and preservation of their corridors & habitations by enrichment plantation and restoration of Elephant Corridors.

This Human-Elephant Conflict Management and Conservation plan has been prepared as part of the compliance report against the grant of IPA, which need to be submitted to MoEF&CC for grant of Stage II Final Forest Clearance for the proposed drilling location KNEB involving diversion of 5.6 ha forestland in northern part of Dhansiri Reserve Forest under Karbi Anglong West Forest Division. The corresponding FC proposal Number is FP/AS/MIN/51724/2020. The location is about 15 km from NH-36, connecting Diphu town with Dimapur and 2 km south of Daldali Railway Station.

This Human-Elephant Conflict Mitigation and Wildlife Conservation Plan covers the well location KNEB located within the forest area.

3.0) Latitude and longitude details and Map of Location KNEB is given in Table 1 below:

OIL proposes to drill Exploratory well at location KNEB within the block boundary of AA-ONN-2010/2. The proposed well site was selected based primarily on the geological consideration and environmental sensitivities, viz: presence of sensitive ecological habitats, settlements, schools/ hospitals, water bodies etc. Care had been taken to locate the well distantly from these receptors. Proper environmental and safety measures would be adopted to minimize footprints on these receptors.

4.0) Environmental Setting of the Block AA-ONN-2010/2:

- The AA-ONN-2010/2 block falls under the humid sub-tropical climate zone with warm seasons and the area is having undulating plains to low hills, which are part of Karbi plateau.



- No Wildlife Sanctuary, National Park or any PAs are located within 10 kilometres from the location KNEB (located in Dhansiri Reserve Forest, under Karbi Anglong East Forest Division).
- Distances of the location KNEB from the PAs are- **Assam's** (Marat Longri Sanctuary is 26.47 Km away, Garampani WLS is 74.8 Km away, East Karbi Anglong WLS is 76.8 Km away & North Karbi Anglong WLS is 86 Km away) and **Nagaland's** (Rangapahar WLS is 22 Km away & Ntangki NP is 86 Km away).
- Dhansiri-Lumding Elephant Reserve, notified in 2003, is falling within the 396 Sq. km block area of AA-ONN-2010/2.
- Two RFs- Dhansiri RF and Daldali RF falls within the block. Daldali RF covers northern part of the block and Dhansiri RF towards southern part of the block. These are Tropical Moist Deciduous and Tropical Semi-evergreen type forests (Choudhury 1993a).
- The project involves diversion of 5.6 ha forestland in Dhansiri RF and there is no requirement of non-forestlands.
- Land use and land cover in the total 396 Sq. km area of AA-ONN-2010/2 Block: Reserve Forest (67.39%), Unclassified Forest (17.87%), Open scrub (7.44%), Settlements (4.56%), Agricultural lands (2.26%), Road network (0.29%), River (0.11%), Water body (0.19%). Some patches of jhum cultivation are observed at the central part of the block.
- It does not involve any cutting of matured trees or clearance of vegetation while executing the project, however, clearance of herbs and shrubs would be involved in small patches.
- There is no industrial activity within the Block and the surrounding areas. Major settlement areas are located at the Western and Eastern part of the Block.

5.0) Project Cost:

OIL has planned to carry out the proposed project activities in the AA-ONN-2010/2 Block over a period of five (5) years. Total project cost for the exploration and testing at the proposed well location KNEB has been estimated at about INR 50 Crore.

7.0 Conservation Plan for Indian Elephants (*Elephas Maximus Indicus*)

7.1) General Information on Indian Elephants:

Indian elephants may spend up to 19 hours a day feeding, and they can produce about 220 pounds of dung per day while wandering over an area that can cover up to 125 square miles. This helps to disperse germinating seeds. They feed mainly on grasses, but large amounts of tree bark, roots, leaves and small stems are also eaten. Cultivated crops such as bananas, rice, and sugarcane are favoured foods as well. Since they need to drink at least once a day, these elephants are always close to a source of freshwater.

7.3) Physical Description:

Elephas maximus is one of the largest terrestrial organisms. However, Asian elephants are smaller than African elephants and they have the highest body point on the head. Asian elephants have grey skin that is covered with hair. In adults, this hair is sparse, while calves have thicker brown hair. The body length ranges from 550 to 640 cm. The trunk is a distinctive feature of the elephant family (Elephantidae). There is a large degree of sexual dimorphism in elephants. The males are much larger than the females. Males have a height of 240 to 300 cm with a body mass of 3,500 to 6,000 kg. Females are 195 to 240 cm in height with a body mass of 2,000 to 3,500 kg. Males have tusks which are an elongation of the second upper incisors, while females lack tusks. Asian elephants have one finger-like projection at the tip of the trunk and have large flat ears. They have four hooves on the hindfoot (Sukumar 2006; Daniel 1998).

7.4) Habitat:

Asian elephants live in a variety of habitats in the tropical region, including grasslands, tropical evergreen forests, moist deciduous forests, and scrub forests. They typically live in elevations from sea level to 3,000 meters, but elephants that live near the Himalaya Mountains sometimes move up higher than this range in hot weather.

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10 to 15 years old, but this can vary greatly depending on the environment. In general, well-nourished individuals become sexually active at an earlier age. Males become sexually active at around the same age as females, i.e. 10 to 15 years old.

7.9) Present Threats:

1. Habitat fragmentation and habitat degradation due to encroachment of forest areas for non-forest activities, settlements etc.
2. Habitat loss/ alteration of forest area due to increase of agricultural activities.
3. Expansion and development of the existing road & rail networks endangers the movement of the elephants through the designated corridors/ passage
4. Illegal poaching and wildlife trading are also a significant factor in contributing the decline of the species.
5. Loss of genetic viability resulting from small, isolated population increases higher risk of becoming wiped out due to disasters, diseases, inbreeding etc.

The consequences of above-mentioned threats ultimately give rises to human-elephant conflict, which is one of the most challenging problems in terms of future survival of elephants, elephant management and conservation.

8.0) Action Plan for the Conservation of Elephant in association with OIL's Project in AA-ONN-2010/2 Block

The following actions plans should be taken as a priority for future survival and conservation of Indian/Asian Elephants.

1. Providing Solar Fencing, Trenches , Stone Walling, Trip Alarm, Chilli Fences and Early Warning System etc. in the depredation prone localities as well as around the well pad site and campsite of the project to arrest Human-Elephant conflicts and to prevent elephants getting trapped at project site/other places
2. Regular vigilance by the Staff of the Forest Department over the movement of elephants and early warnings to human settlement area is very much essential in conflict prone areas. Kunki elephants may be used in driving away the wild elephants from human settlement areas and crop fields
3. Infrastructure improvement in Elephant Reserves for effective management of elephant population and providing VHF communication system to the forest officials

9.0) Estimated Budget of Rs 1 cr to be spent over 5 years towards Implementation of Human- Elephant Conflict Mitigation and Wildlife Conservation Plan

A budgetary estimate has been proposed for Wildlife Conservation Plan for drilling of well at location KNEB for a total life span of the project of 5 years under the following heads:
