

Compliance Report of In-Principle Approval vide no.3 AS B/091/2022/GHY/2126-2127 dated 17th March 2022 from MoEF & CC, Regional Office, Shillong for diversion of 2.604 Ha forest land for construction of Holongi Airport at Gohpur, Sonitpur East Division.

4	The user agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory afforestation at the current wage rate in consultation with the State Forest Department in the account of CAMPA of the concerned State through online portal. The scheme may include appropriate for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.	The total amount of compensatory afforestation under this proposal Rs.68,68,952 /- has been deposited to Ad-hoc CAMPA as per e-challan dated 14-04-2022.
