In inviting a reference to the subject cited above, I have the honour to submit herewith the compliance report to the stipulated conditions contained in the "In-Principle Approval for diversion of 238 Ha of forest land for relocation of the Forest Village from Laika in Dibru-Saikhowa National Park to Paharpur and Namphai RF under Digboi Forest Division" in Tinsukia District of Assam accorded by the Govt. of India vide File. No.8-01/2021-FC dated 29/03/2021 as stated below.

2A. Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department and compliance to be submitted prior to Stage-II approval:-

MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD AT 1.30 PM ON 28.01.2021 IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF OFFICE OF THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER, TINSUKIA, TINSUKIA REGARDING REHABILITATION ISSUES OF LAIKA PEOPLE.

Members Present in Annexure - A:

At the outset, the Deputy Commissioner, Tinsukia welcomed Sri Jogen Mohan, Hon'ble Minister of State, Revenue & DM department Govt. of Assam and members of subcommittee constituted by Govt. of Assam to monitor and extend support for relocation & rehabilitation of Laika villagers under Tinsukia district. He said that the meeting was convened as per direction of Environment and Forest department, Government of Assam for discussing issues of rehabilitation of Laika people and the meeting was presided over by Sri Jogen Mohan, Hon'ble Minister of State, Revenue & DM department Govt. of Assam.

The following points were discussed.

- i) Sri A.M. Singh, PCCF & HoFF, Environment & Forest Department, Govt. of Assam said initiating the discussion stated that the sub-committee has come to Tinsukia to discuss about how to provide support to all concerned in connection with shifting of the Laika people at Paharpur (166 ha) and Namphai (72 ha) RF which have been identified by forest department for total 543 households. He requested all concerned department to provide necessary support for making a suitable/livelihood environment at the areas by convergence of all departments. He further said that after the meeting the sub-committee will meet the inmates of Laika-Dadhia at the protest site and also visit the areas where shifting has been prepared.
- ii) Sri Jogen Mohan, Hon'ble Minister of State, Revenue & DM department Govt. of Assam stated that proposal of rehabilitation forest village at Paharpur and Namphai FR area have been sent to environment & forest department government of India for approval. He desires to solve the issue at an early date requested all concerned department to prepare plan & estimate and submit the same to Deputy Commissioner, Tinsukia within 31st January,2021.
- iii) AGM, APDCL, Tinsukia stated that they have already prepared plan and estimates for Paharpur and Namphai area for providing new service connection to the people who will be shifted. The estimated amount of the new installation of power supply for both areas will be 5 Ccrore 60 Lakhs and will submit same within the stipulated date.
- iv) EE, PHE department has stated that they have also prepared two plan & estimate for providing drinking water facility and individual household latrine to the relocated people of Laika for both immediate and permanent measures. If area is notified forest village than semi permanent measure can be taken. Amount may be around Rs.5.00 crores and plan & estimated are being prepared and will be submitted shortly.



- v) CEO, Tinsukia Zila Parishad stated that geo-tagging for the newly created villages at Paharpur & Namphai RF will be carried out under concerned Panchayats and accordingly scheme of PMAY house will be implemented. Hon'ble minister also requested the house to take the matter to implement PMAY scheme at that areas with Government of Assam immediately. The rate for PMAY household is Rs.1.30 lacs per household.
- vi) EE PWD, Digboi-Margherita territorial road division stated that to reach Paharpur one RCC bridge (L 74 meters) is required over river Tirap and plan & estimate are being prepared amounting to Rs.9.00 crore. He said that one small bridge (L 18.75 M) is also required in that area. For road connectivity including bridge, project concept papers will be prepared and submitted within the next months i.e., 1st week of Feb, 2021.
- vii) Jt Director of Health Services, Tinsukia stated that one PHC is functioning at Jagun and it will cover the Paharpur area. Hon'ble Minister suggested helath department to keep one Ambulance stationed (24 X 7) in Paharpur area to meet up for emergency health issue of the people.
- viii) DEEO, Tinsukia said that one LP school is running at Paharpur area and 2 LP schools are at Namphai area. Children may be accommodated accordingly after getting the exact number of children. Deputy Commissioner, Tinsukia requested DFO(W/L), Tinsuka to submit the number of children of Laika village as per record available with him within the 31st January,2021. Inspector of School, Tinsukia also stated that there is one High School namely Tirap High School is functioning at Tirap area which located about 4.5 KM from Paharpur and 10 Kms from Namphai area.
- ix) Regarding ration cards as the same have already been issued, it was decided that the names of the beneficiaries will be shifted to new location.
- x) Supply department stated that for gas connection facilities "Ujjwala scheme" have already been going on and people of Laika are also under the schemes and they can also use the connection at their new location.
- xi) Agriculture department stated that seeds are kept available at District Agricultural Officer, Tinsukia for distribution among the proposed rehabilitated farmers of Laika. The growing season of Maize is continuing and farmer can sow seeds for production of Maize along with rephrases for cattle.
- viii) Veterinary department stated that a roadmap to support the relocated families of Laika have been prepared covering piggery and poultry farming and financial backup may be taken by convergence with NRLM/ASRLM/MGNREGA/Bank finance-PMKCC etc. Veterinary department will provide all necessary support to the farmers as and when required.
- xiii) The house suggested to include Sri Bhaskar Sharma, Hon'ble MLA, Margherita and Sri Suren Phukan, Hon'ble MLA, Digboi as members of the sub-committee which was constituted by government of Assam. The house also suggested to send proposal to Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam for providing financial assistance to the people as livelihood during the time of

shifting. All concerned departments are requested to submit their proposal, plan & estimate by 31st January, 2021 and complied report to be send to government for approval.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks from the chair.

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Village Relocation Plan

INTRODUCTION-

Name of National Park -- Dibru- Saikhowa National Park

Name of the Forest Village to be relocated — Laika

Total area of Laika Forest Village --238 ha

Legal Status --Forest Village

Two nos. of Forest villages Laika FV and Dodhia FV were established in 1951-52 and 1956-57 respectably within Dibru Reserve Forest and Saikhowa Reserve Forest under Dibrugarh & Doomdooma Forest Division, respectively. The sanctioned area of Laika FV is 238 ha and that of Dodhia FV is 135 ha as per notification of Dibru-Saikhowa Wildlife Sanctuary.

In 1986, by amalgamating both the Reserve Forest, a Wildlife Sanctuary was constituted vide Govt. of Assam's Notification No.FRW.51/86/8 dt. 26/09/1986 Namely Dibru-Saikhowa Wildlife Sanctuary with an area of 340 sq.km by keeping the two Forest Villages inside the Sanctuary (Annexure I-Notification of WLS)

During 1999 the entire area of 340 sq km was declared as Dibru –Saikhowa National Park by way of upgrading the existing Dibru-Saikhowa Wildlife Sanctuary as per provision of wildlife Protection Act. 1972, vide Govt. of Assam's notification no. FRW.21/90/171 dtd. 05/03/1999. (Annexure II-Notification of Dibru Saikhowa National Park)

As there is no non-forest land available in the district hence the Reserve Forest land has been selected for rehabilitation of Foest Village Laika. As the Dibru- Saikhowa National Park is very flood prone and the notification of Wildlife Sanctuary itself speaks about the relocation of the forest village, the rehabilitation of Laika Forest Village is prerequisite not only for the betterment of Forest Villagers but for conservation of the Dibru- Saikhowa National Park also.

The relocation will lead to the improvement of the habitat of the Dibru-Saikhowa National Park. After the complete relocation of the both Forest Villages Dodhia and Laika the core area of the Dibru-Saikhowa National Park will be completely free of anthropogenic pressure and in future many wildlife activities like introduction of Rhinoceros can be taken up. It is pertinent to mention that Dibru-Saikhowa National Park harvours 500 plus species of birds, Gangetic Dolphin, Hoolock Gibbon, wild Feral Horses among many prominent wildlife species.

Total 238 ha land will be diverted for relocation and rehabilitation of Laika Forest Village against the total area of 238 ha which was allotted to Laika village as per notification of Dibru Saikhowa National Park.

Relocation committee

A committee was formed vide notification no FRM107/2020329 dated 5th January 2021 under the chairmanship of Hon'ble forest minister for the relocation and rehabilitation of the villagers. The minutes of meeting of the committee is attached along with.

Relocation Subcommittee

A subcommittee was formed under the chairmanship of Hon'ble minister of State, Revenue and Disaster Management for convergence of various schemes of government for the relocated persons. In this regards a meeting of subcommittee was further held in the Office of Deputy Commissioner, Tinsukia along with various line departments for the identifying the various schemes that can be provided for the rehabilitated families. Schemes estimating to approximately Rs 50 crores has been identified for the villagers of Laika to facilitate various facilities. (copy of minutes attached – Annexure 1)

Additionally, an initial amount of Rs 1,00,000/- family is being distributed by the government to meet the initial expenses during relocation of both Laika and Dodhia villages.
