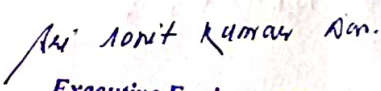

1	The user agency shall transfer, the Net Present Value (NPV) in the revised rate of forest land being diverted under this proposal as per the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in Writ petition (Civil) No. 202/1995 and as per guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No. 5-3/2007-FC dated 05.02.2009 and File No.5-3/2011-FC(Vol-I) dated 21.03.2022. The requisite fund shall be transferred through online portal into CAMPA account of the State concerned;	The Net Present Value of the forest land diverted under the proposal for Rs. 29,70,954/- has been deposited to CAMPA account as per e-challan dated 12.04.2023 and the payment details are enclosed at Annexure-A
2	The non-forest land proposed for CA shall be transferred and muted in the name of Forest Department and notified as RF/PF prior to stage-II approval. A copy of the original notification declaring the non-forest land under Section 4 or Section 29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927, or under the relevant section of State Forest Act as the case may be, will be submitted by the State Government prior to Stage-II approval. 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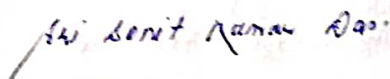

2	The compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the forest department over 5 ha non forest land identified in Dag No. 835 in Dakhin Mandakata under Barbongshar Mouza, under Sila Range of North Kamrup Division, Rangia in Kamrup(Rural) district of Assam within three years from the date of stage-II Clearance and maintained thereafter by the State Forest Department at the cost of the User Agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. 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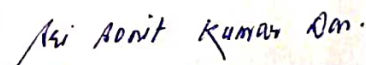

[d] Removing all the unauthorized construction inside the site. [e] Curative conservation of the rock inscription. [f] Construction of transparent shed over the rock inscription for protection.
