महोदय,

उपरोक्त विषयक संदर्भित पत्र का आशय ग्रहण करने का कष्ट करें जिसके द्वारा प्रश्नगत प्रकरण में वन संरक्षण अधिनियम, 1980 की धारा 2 के अंतर्गत भारत सरकार की स्वीकृति मांगी गयी थी। प्रकरण के परीक्षणोपरान्त और आरईसी की पंचम बैठक दिनांक 30.05.2022 में निर्णय के आधार पर केन्द्र सरकार उपरोक्त विषयांकित परियोजना हेतु 9.58 हे० वन भूमि के पत्यावर्तन एवं 5104 वृक्षों के पातन की सैद्धान्तिक स्वीकृति (In-principle/Stage-I approval) निम्नलिखित शर्तों पर प्रदान की गयी थी, उक्त शर्तों की अनुपालना एवं वचनबद्धता निम्न प्रकार है:-

We agree to abide by this condition. Net Present Value (NPV) for the 9.58 ha forest area to be diverted under this proposal has been deposited by User Agency vide Challan No. 61142233050 dated 16.06.2022. Enclosed as Annexure-I.
3.	The non-forest land proposed for CA shall be transferred and mutated in favour of State Forest Department	We agree to abide by this condition.
4.	The non-forest land proposed for CA shall be transferred and mutated in the name of Forest Department and notified as RF/PF prior to Stage-II approval. A copy of the original notification declaring the non-forest land under Section 4 or Section 29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927, or under the relevant section of the State Forest Act as the case may be, will be submitted by the State Government prior to Stage-II approval.	We agree to abide by this condition.
5.	In compliance of guidelines of MoEF&CC issued vide letter No. 17/24/2019-FC dated 26.11.2019, the non-forest land proposed for Compensatory Afforestation shall be declared as Protected Forest under relevant provisions of Indian Forest Act, 1927 or site specific Act, if any. It is informed that you shall deposit an amount of Rs. 86682235/- (Rupees Eight Crore Sixty Six Lakh Eighty Two Thousand Two Hundred and Thirty Five only) which include the cost of creation of 10645 saplings, their maintenance for ten years and anticipated cost increase @7.5%
2. With respect to point no. 2, it is informed that the Net Present Value (NPV) for 9.58 ha of forest area to be diverted amounts to Rs. 13001114/- (Rupees One Crore Thirty Lakh One Thousand One Hundred and Fourteen only).
