With reference to the above mentioned subject, the compliance to the  
conditions raised in this principal approval is given as under:- (Proposal No.  
FP/DN/Road/148752/2021).

(A) 1	The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.	Agreed The amount of Rs. 1,78,24,045/- has been deposited by PWD on dtd. 25.08.2023 in A/C No. 150656148752890 & Rs. 75,42,022/- 1506561148752701, on dtd. 19.05.2023 Union Bank of India vide UTR No. SBINR 52023082518424236 & SBINR 52023082518424237 in favour of DADRA NAGARAM CAMPA

2	The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the <u>2.4813 ha</u> forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in IA No. 566 in WP (C) No. 202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II) dated 18/09/2003, as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007 FC dated 05/02/2009 and <b>revision of NPV vide Ministry letter No. 5-3/2011:F-C(Vol-1) dated 06.01.2022</b> in this regard.	Agreed Deposited as above.
3	Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.	Agreed
4	The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector	Agreed
5	The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the direction of concerned Divisional Forest Officer.	Agreed
6	The KML file of the area to be diverted and the CA areas shall be uploaded on the e-Green watch portal with all requisite details, before issuing working permission towards linear projects or submitting compliance report for seeking Stage-II approval, as the case may be.	Agreed
7	All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/ deposited to CAM PA fund only through e-portal.	Agreed
(B) – 1	Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.	Agreed
2	Forest land will be handed over to the User Agency only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the User Agency.	Agreed
3	Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 5.00 ha de-graded forest land, Survey No. 8, Village- Nana Randha, Range Northen Range, Taluka/District U.T. Dadra & Nagar Haveli at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and mono-culture of any species may be avoided.	Agreed
4	User agency shall restrict the felling of trees to 250 trees/minimum numbers in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under strict supervision of the State Forest Department and cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.	Agreed



5	No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused.	Agreed
6	The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.	Agreed
7	No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.	Agreed
8	Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.	Agreed
9	The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.	Agreed
10	No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.	Agreed
11	The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less.	Agreed
12	The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.	Agreed
13	The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Govt. of India.	Agreed
14	The User Agency shall submit the annual self-compliance report in respect of the above stated conditions to the State Government and Integrated Regional Office, Gandhinagar by the end of March every year.	Agreed
15	The User Agency shall comply with all the provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, Hon'ble Court Order (s) and NGT Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.	Agreed

16	Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guideline F. No. 11-42/2017-FC dt 29/01/2018.	Agreed
17	Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.	Agreed
