Sir,


This has reference to the above cited subject regarding diversion of 0.06Ha of forest land in survey no.135 of Torxem Village North Goa Division for the above mentioned project. In this connection, it is submitted that :

1. A vehicular underpass is constructed at Ch.475/000 as per contract agreement with service road on either sides.
2. The said work was taken up on emergency basis considering the stage -I clearance, after payment of the NPV.
3. In the absence of service road and underpass, the residents of village Patradevi and traffic coming from Village Banda, State Maharashtra would have faced problem in crossing the National Highway. Hence, the service lanes had to be constructed to avoid accidents and to reduce inconvenience to the road users pending stage-II approval.
4. National Highway Division of PWD is taking up the 4-laning of Highways on behalf of Ministry of Road Transport and Highway (MoRTH) and the stage - 1 approval was conveyed by the IRO, Bangalore in December, 2019. Accordingly, the NPV was paid during July, 2020. After payment of the NPV and since being a linear project, the work was taken up on emergency basis considering the stage -I clearance as deemed to be the working permission for commencement of the work. Apart from payment of NPV, no other compliances were to be made form the part of the User Agency as per the guidelines of MoEFCC dated 8th August, 2014.

As regard KML drawing, the site was inspected by subdivisinal office with the officials of Forest Department and KML drawing of land in question is corrected as per site conditions and submitted for needful action.

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In view of above, the compliance report along with the KML file may be considered for granting the stage-II approval please.
