No. 137, Village-Don, Taluka-Ahwa, District-Dang at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local native species shall be planted and monoculture of any species, especially non-native species should be avoided.	No trees will be harmed during execution of this project	
3	Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall also be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. 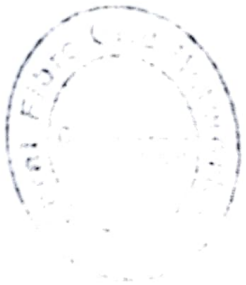

9	The User Agency shall provide alternate fuels preferably LPG to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.	Noted

11	The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of the project life.	Noted
