- 1. A proposal was received vide reference no. 1 above for diversion of 0.9874 ha land for laying of Optical Fiber Cable by Reliance Jio Infocom Limited in Gir Wildlife Sanctuary.
- The proposal was placed before the State Board for Wildlife (SBWL) in its 12th meeting held on 25-04-2017 for consultation. The SBWL has approved and recommended the proposal in its meeting vide reference no. 2 above with certain conditions.
 - 3. The proposal was sent to Forest and Environment Department, Government of Gujarat vide reference no. 3 above for onward submission to MoEF&CC, Gol. The said proposal was submitted to MoEF&CC, Gol for consideration of Standing Committee of National Board for (NBWL) vide reference no. 4 above. The proposal was discussed in 43rd meeting of the Standing Committee of NBWL held on 27-06-2017, and the Standing Committee of NBWL reference no. 5 above in its meeting with certain conditions.

LICENSON DESCRIPTION LES ORDERS CORDERS STRELLANCE JO 0,9874, doc

4. Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has passed an order dated 05-10-2015 in reference to different I.As in Writ Petition (Civil) 202/95 vide reference no. 6 above. The order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India is reproduced as under:

"All matters for grant of permissions for implementation of projects in areas falling in National parks/sanctuaries, including rationalization of boundaries etc. will be considered by the Standing Committee of the National Board for Wildlife ("NBWL") on its own merits and in conformity with the orders and directions passed by this Court from time to time, i.e. on 14.02.2000, 13.11.2000, 9.5.2002, 16.12.2002, 25.11.2005 and 14.09.2007 and other subsequent clarificatory orders/judgment(s) passed by this Court including the Goa Foundation Judgment, i.e. Goa Foundation Vs. Union of India & Ors., reported in (2014) 6 SCC 590.

We request the NBWL to furnish a copy of the orders passed by it within 30 days' time to the C.E.C. The C.E.C. is at liberty, if, for any reason, they are aggrieved by the decision of the Standing Committee of NBWL to approach this Court by filing an

appropriate petition/application.

In all those matters where there is already decision of the Standing Committee of the NBWL shall abide the parties with all the conditions imposed therein.

If any party is aggrieved by the decision of the Standing Committee of the NBWL, they

are at liberty to approach an appropriate forum for appropriate relief(s).

With the aforesaid observations and directions, we dispose of the Interlocutory Applications/matters specified in Annexure-II to the note supplied by Shri Harish Salve, learned amicus curiae."

5. Therefore in view of the references mentioned and explained above, the permission is hereby granted to the Reliance Jio Infocom Limited, Ahmedabad for diversion of 0.9874 ha land (21942 m length and 0.45 m width in Block Sasan - 5, Alavani - 9, Surajgadh -2, Gir Forest and S.No. 23 of Protected Forest) of Gir Wildlife Sanctuary for laying of Optical Fiber Cable subject to following conditions:

Conditions:

1. The User Agency shall not violate any regulatory provisions under Section - 9, 17 A, 27, 29, 30, 31 & 32 of Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972.

2. The User agency shall not destroy wildlife habitat including fauna and flora of the Gir Wildlife Sanctuary.

3. The User Agency shall not use the area for the proposed work other than the area permitted.

The User Agency shall not establish any temporary or permanent labour camp in the Gir Wildlife Sanctuary.

5. The User Agency or his contractor shall not create any fire places inside the Gir Wildlife Sanctuary.

All the material required for the work shall be prepared outside the sanctuary. The work in the Sanctuary will be allowed only in the day time from 8 AM to 6 PM. Approval under Forest Conversation Act, 1980, if required, shall be obtained separately for use of forest land.

- 11. Soil conservation measures, if required, should be taken up by the User Agency for which fund should be provided as per the current rate of works.
- 12. No felling of tree shall be involved in the implementation of the proposal.
- 13. No damage shall be done to flora & fauna.

132 Stage-I, Others New

- 14. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials to be used for execution of the project work. Camps shall not be allowed in Forest Area.
- 15. Proposed temporary labour camps outside the forest area are to be dismantled and removed. The labourers shall be sent back immediately after the completion of the work.
- 16. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.

- 17. The user agency shall comply to the conditions stipulated in the minutes of meeting of 43rd National Board of Wildlife meeting and conditions stipulated in the clearance letter of CWLW, Forest Department, Govt. of Gujarat vide letter No. WLP/32/B/3638-43/2017-18 dated 27.07.2017.
- 18. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Central Government.
- 19. The User Agency shall provide fuel preferably alternate fuel to the staff and labourers working at the site to avoid damage /felling of trees and pressure on forest areas.
- 20. The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of User Agency or the project life whichever is less.
- 21. a) The User Agency shall submit compliance report as on 1st January of every year to the Nodal Officer of the State.
 - b) The State Government shall monitor compliance of conditions of Forest Clearance and shall submit in this regard yearly report as on 31st July of every year.
- 22. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
- 23. Statutory provisions under various Acts, rules made there under and guidelines applicable to this project shall be strictly adhered to.
- 24. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation and development of forests & wildlife.
- 25. The compliance report shall be uploaded on e.portal (http://forestsclearance.nic.in).

The compliance report on condition Nos. 3 (a, b), 4, 5, 6, 7 and 25 shall be sent to this office. Transfer of Forest land to User Agency shall not be affected by the State Government till the formal approval for diversion of forest land is issued by the this office.
