**Sub. Diversion of 0.1785 ha. of forest land for access to permission for transportation of mining area at Village Khanak, under Forest Division Bhiwani. (Online proposal No. FR/HR/Approach/146575/2021).**

Sir,

1. The State Govt. has sanctioned lease of an area of 258.30 hectares to Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructure Corporation Ltd. (HSIIDC) for stone mining in village Khanak, Tehsil Tosham, District Bhiwani, for a period of 20 years vide Lol dated 03.01.2014.
2. The Corporation obtained Environmental Clearance enhanced capacity of 24 MTPA vide letter dated 08.08.2023 from SEIAA, Panchkula. The Corporation has issued letter no. 790 dated 03-09-2024 to M/s Dhansar Engineering Company Pvt. Ltd., Dhanbad regarding Augmentation of production/dispatch from 10 million ton per annum (MTPA) to 24 million ton per annum (MTPA).
3. In this regard, for Right of Way Hisar-Tosham Road an online application number FP/HR/Approach/146575/2021 on website of Parivesh, Ministry of Environment Forest & Climate Change, Government of India was filed by the Corporation on 30.08.2021. NoC has been taken from PWD & B&R Haryana on dated 15.12.2021 and NOC from Directorate of Town & Country Planning on dated 18.11.2021.
4. The online proposal for seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section 2 (1) (ii) of the (Van Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan Adhiniyam, 1980) has been approved in principle in favour of M/s HSIIDC Stone Mines, Khanak for non-forestry use of 0.1785 hac. of Protected Forest land for access permission for transportation of mining material vehicles at Village- Khanak under Forest Division and District Bhiwani in the State of Haryana (Proposal No. FP/HR/Approach/146575/2021).
5. With reference to your office letter no. 2697 dated 12.02.2026 regarding payment of revised fee/charges amounting to Rs.90,13,459/- in CAMPA Haryana account with utilization of forest land for access to HSIIDC, Mine Project, Khanak.
6. In compliance with the above, HSIIDC has transferred the said amount through RTGS vide Transaction No. S30499966 (NRTGS/PUNBR52026021213098099/CAMPA) in favour of CAMPA, Haryana on 12.02.2026. The same has also been uploaded on the PARIVESH Portal.
7. An undertaking in this regard, as required, is enclosed herewith for your kind perusal and record.
8. It is therefore requested that further necessary action may kindly be taken at your end for processing the case and granting final approval/permission. This is for your kind information and necessary action, please.

## Undertaking

**Proposal for seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section 2 (1) (ii) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 in favour of M/s. HSIIDC Stone Mines, Khanak for non-forestry use of 0.1785 ha. of Protected Forest land for access permission for transportation of mining material at Village-Khanak under Forest Division and District Bhiwani in the State of Haryana (Proposal No. FP/HR/Approach/146575/2021)**

**I/we on behalf of HSIIDC undertake as under:**

1. Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The Compensatory Afforestation shall be raised over 1.00 ha degraded forest land at the cost of the Project within two years from the date of grant of Stage II approval. Details of CA including KML, site suitability certificate etc. needs to be submitted along with Stage- I compliance report.
3. The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and 9-HRB129/2022-CHA I/150158/2025 9-HRB129/2022-CHA I/150158/2025 erection of permanent pillars, if required, on the CA land, shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the user agency. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include afforestation of indigenous species with appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years, into the account of National Authority, CAMPA managed by the State Govt.
4. At the time of payment of the Net Present Value (NPV) at the then prevailing rate, the User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
5. The Compensatory levies to be realized from the User Agency under the project shall be transferred/ deposited, through e-challan, in to the account of National, CAMPA pertaining to the State concerned through e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>)
6. The complete compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>).
7. The User Agency shall pay the five (5) times penal NPV for the extent of violation done plus 12 percent simple interest from the date of raising of such demand till the deposit is made by the User Agency.
8. The cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
9. The user agency shall explore the possibility of translocation of maximum number of trees identified to be felled and shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department, if required.
10. The user agency shall explore the possibility of translocation of maximum number of trees identified to be felled and shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department, if required
11. The User Agency shall be responsible for any loss to the flora and fauna in the Surrounding. Any damage done in this regard shall be compensated by the User Agency from the project cost as per assessment of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.

12. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land and the User Agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.
13. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
14. The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS coordinates.
15. The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less; xxi. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
16. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
17. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government.
18. No damage to the flora, fauna or the environment of the adjoining area shall be caused; Adequate measures to ensure no damage to the adjoining areas should be taken by the User Agency at the project cost;
19. The concerned Divisional Forest Officer, will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in the surrounding area.
20. The User Agency shall submit the annual self -compliance report in respect of the above stated conditions to the State Government, concerned Regional Office and to this Ministry by the end of March every year regularly.
21. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife shall be carried with by the State Government and user agency.
22. The user agency shall comply all the provisions of all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, Hon'ble Court Order (s) and NGT Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project; and.
23. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhinyam, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed in para 1.16 of Chapter 1 of the consolidated guidelines and clarifications issued under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhinyam, 1980 and Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rules, 2023 as issued by this Ministry's letter No. 5-2/2017-FC dated 29.12.2023.






