

2.5	No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.	Agreed
2.6	Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel;	Agreed
2.7	No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work;	Agreed
2.8	The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less;	Agreed
2.9	The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal;	Agreed
2.10	The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without approval of the Government of India.	Agreed
2.11	Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.	Agreed
3.	User Agency shall obtain Environment Clearance or any other clearance, if applicable under any act/rule/order/guideline etc for the proposal	Agreed
4.	After receipt of the compliance report on fulfilment of the conditions under para-2, above, final approval order shall be given under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The use of forestland will not be allowed till final approval is accorded.	Agreed



Subject: Request for issue of Forest Right Act for the diversion of Forest land for upgradation of road from Kotli to Shikari, Package No. JK14-739, PMGSY II length 7.00 Kms.

In reference to letter No.11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3rd August 2009 of Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India wherein guidelines on submission of evidences have been issued for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain exemption/relaxation in respect of linear projects, **it is certified that:**

- (i) The length= 7.00 Kms (Area 0.5975 Hectare) of forest land is proposed to be diverted for the for upgradation of road from Kotli to Shikari, Package No. JK14-739, PMGSY II length 7.00 Kms.
- (ii) Tehsildar Chassana vide No. TC/2026-27/77-78 dated 12.05.2026 has intimated that No recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups (PTG) and Pre Agricultural Communities (PAC) shall be affected in diversion of forest land for non forest use for upgradation of road from Kotli to Shikari, Package No. JK14-739, PMGSY II length 7.00 Kms

Hence, Forest Right Act certificate is issued for forest land measuring 0.5975 Hectare required for upgradation of road from Kotli to Shikari, Package No. JK14-739, PMGSY II length 7.00 Kms.
