Reference to the online proposal dated 20.04.2021 submitted on PARIVESH PORTAL of MOEF&CC for Diversion 2.4 ha of Forest Land for Construction of road upto TRT outlet, Kwar HE Project, Kishtwar, U.T. of Jammu & Kashmir, the In-principle forest clearance has been accorded by Integrated Regional Office (IRO), Jammu, MOEF&CC vide referred letter dated 15.07.2021 with certain conditions to be complied by user agency and DFO, Kishtwar.

In this regard, Kwar HE Project, CVPPPL has complied conditions of the clearance letter dated 15.07.2021. The point wise compliance/ undertaking are submitted as under:

Part (A) - Conditions Part (A)- Conditions to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the UT forest department:

- I. Cost of compensatory afforestation as per CA scheme, as per confirmation of demand by Nodal Officer, has been deposited through online challan on PARIVESH Portal. A copy of requisition from DFO, Kishtwar, confirmation of demand by Nodal Officer, Online Challan and a copy of payment made are enclosed for reference.
- II. Cost of Net Present Value (NPV) of forest land being diverted for non-forestry purpose, as per confirmation of demand by Nodal Officer has been deposited through online challan on PARIVESH Portal. A copy of requisition from DFO,

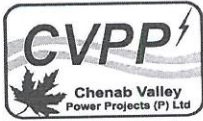
Kishtwar, confirmation of demand by Nodal Officer, Online Challan and a copy of payment made are enclosed for reference.

- III. The cost of Net Present Value (NPV) and compensatory levies has been deposited through web portal of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (www.parivesh.nic.in). Condition stand complied.
- IV. The user agency (CVPPPL) has ensured that compensatory levies (CA cost, NPV etc.) has been deposited through challan generated online on web portal and deposited in appropriate bank only. A copy of online generated challan, confirmation of Nodal Officer and receipt of online payment through Parivesh Portal are enclosed for reference.
- V. Pertains to DFO, Kishtwar.
- VI. User agency shall ensure that no violation of any of the conditions of the clearance letter shall take place.
- VII. Pertains to DFO, Kishtwar.
- VIII. Pertains to CEO, State CAMPA.
- IX. A copy of FRA certificate issued by Dy. Commissioner, Kishtwar is enclosed. Condition stand complied.

Part (B) – Conditions which needs to be strictly complied on field after handing over of forest land to the user agency.

- i) Noted that legal status of forest land will remain unchanged.
- ii) All efforts shall be made to ensure minimum number of tree felling, keeping restrictions of not more than 517 trees and 4288 U/s poles.
- iii) The muck generated shall be dumped in the designated dumping site and it will be ensured that no muck will be dumped in the forest land.
- iv) Pertains to DFO, Kishtwar.
- v) The forest land shall be used for road purposes only.
- vi) The forest land purposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without approval of the Central Government.
- vii) The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.
- viii) Kwar HE Project, CVPPPL (User Agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road at the project cost as per IRC specifications with maintenance of 7 years to 10 years.



- ix) Kwar HE Project shall ensure no damage will be done to the adjoining forest land.
- x) Kwar HE Project shall ensure that no labour camps shall be established on the forest land.
- xi) Kwar HE Project, CVPPPL (User Agency) shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased on the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- xii) Kwar HE Project, CVPPPL (User Agency) shall provide firewood preferable alternative fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest area.
- xiii) Kwar HE Project, CVPPPL (User Agency) shall agree to any other conditions that Regional Office may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests and wildlife.
- xiv) Noted, (User Agency) shall ensure to obtain all other prior approvals/clearance under all other relevant Acts/Rules/Courts Ruling/Instructions etc, if required.

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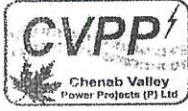

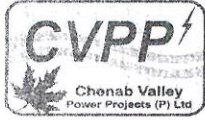

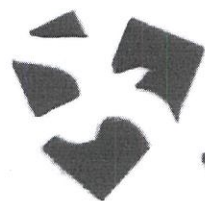

Please refer to the above cited subject and letters seeking prior approval of the Central government for the diversion of **2.4 ha** of Forest land for non-forestry purpose in accordance with section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

2. After careful examination of the proposal of the UT Administration of J&K, in-principle approval is hereby conveyed for the diversion **2.4 ha** of Forest land for the above mentioned project, subject to the following condition:

(A). Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the UT Forest Department.

- I. Cost of compensatory afforestation as per CA scheme may be realized from user agency.
- II. Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted for non-forestry purpose may be realized from the user agency, as per Ministry's directions issued vide letters No. 5-3/2007-FC dated 5th February 2009 and Hon'ble Supreme Court of India's Order dated 30th October 2002, 28th March, 2008, 24th April, 2008 and 9th May 2008;
- III. As per the orders of the Government of India vide letter No. 5-2/2010-CAMPA 24.06.2011, the Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land and all other CA levies shall be deposited through web portal of Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change www.parivesh.nic.in.
- IV. User Agency should ensure that the compensatory levies (CA cost, NPV etc.) are deposited through challan generated online on web portal and deposited in appropriate bank only. Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of the Stage-I clearance.
- V. The UT of J&K shall not issue temporary working permission until entire compensatory levies are deposited by the User Agency and confirmed online on Ministry's web portal.
- VI. Violation of any these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action will be taken as prescribed in Para 1.21 of Chapter 1 of the Handbook of

- VIII. **CEO State CAMPA shall furnish undertaking that the funds under state/UT CAMPA will be released to Divisional Forest Officer as per approved CA scheme.**
- IX. FRA certificate from competent Authority to be submitted.

(B) Conditions which need to be strictly complied on field after handing over of forest land to the user agency by the UT Forest Department but the compliance in form of undertaking shall be submitted prior to Stage-II approval

- i. Legal status of the forest land will remain unchanged;
- ii. Efforts should be made to fell minimum number of trees and in any case, not more than **517 Trees & 4288 U/s Poles** will be felled.
- iii. No muck will be dumped in the forest land as the muck dumping sites have been identified on non-forest land;
- iv. The DFO shall ensure that User agency shall not dump muck on forest land;
- v. The forest land will not be used for any other purpose than that mentioned in the proposal;
- vi. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department, or person without approval of the Central Government;
- vii. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government;
- viii. The user agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road at the project cost as per IRC specifications with maintenance of seven to ten years;
- ix. No damage will be done to the adjoining forest land;
- x. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land;
- xi. The user agency shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased on the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court;
- xii. The User Agency shall provide firewood preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas;
- xiii. Any other condition that this Regional Office may stipulate, from time to time, in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife;
- xiv. It will be the responsibility of the State Government/User Agency to obtain all other prior approvals/clearances under all other relevant Acts/Rules/ Court's Rulings/instructions, etc., including environmental clearance, as applicable to this proposal




