**UNDERTAKING**

I Dirsha kumari, Block Development Officer, Chanunta do hereby solemnly affirm & declare as under:-

1. That Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged;
2. That efforts should be made to fell minimum number of trees;
3. That the CA will be carried out on degraded forest land as per the CA scheme and the funds will be provided by the user agency. The plantation of 1000 trees per ha (or proportionately less if forest area diverted is less than 01 Ha will be done within one year from the date of issue of the approval;
4. That the layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government;
5. That No labour camp shall be established on the forest land;
6. That Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel;
7. That No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work;
8. That the period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less;
9. I do hereby undertake to pay additional of NPV of the deviated forest land if any becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble supreme court of India on receipt of report from the expert committee.
10. That the forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Govt. of India; and
11. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.

In compliance of the Rule 6(3)(e) of the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003 [as amended vide the Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2014; Forest (Conservation) second Amendment Rules 2014; and Forest (Conservation) second Amendment Rules 2016, it is certified that 0.11 hectare of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Block Development Officer, Chanunta for construction of Tractor road from Kali Dabbar to Gair Bus Stand, Panchayat Ser Manjla, Block Chanunta, Tehsil Ramnagar in Forest Division Ramanagar in Udhampur district falls within jurisdiction of village **Sermanjla** in Tehsil **Ramnagar**. It is further certified that:

- (c) The complete process for Identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 0.11 hectare of forest area proposed for diversion. As per MoEF issued vide No. F. No. 11-9/98-FC(9pt) dated 5<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2013 for linear projects like constructions of **roads, canals, laying of pipelines/optical fibre and transmission lines etc.**, there is no requirement of resolution of the Gram Sabha of the area, based on full and prior information of the project and a public hearing, endorsing that the project is in the Interest of the people living on the forest land, use of which is proposed to be diverted for non-forest purpose;
- (d) The proposal does not involve recognized right of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural communities as reported by Block Development Officer, Chanunta vide No. BDOC/2021-22/1074 dated 22.12.2021.
