

UNDERTAKING

(UNQUALIFIED COMMITMENT FROM THE PROJECT OFFICIAL AS PER THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF IN-PRINCIPLE APPROVAL ACCORDED BY FOREST, ENVIRONMENT AND ECOLOGY DEPARTMENT AND ECOLOGY DEPARTMENT UT OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR)

1. It is to state that the PWD(R&B) Division Ramnagar, UT of J&K who is the Project Authority for the diversion of 5.6 ha' forest land for non-forest use in the "Upgradation of road from Thial to Chountra Mata Km 6th RD 0 to Km 19th RD 500 Distt. Udhampur UT of Jammu & Kashmir Under CRF "hereby agree on the below mentioned points as per the Terms and conditions of Forest, Environment and Ecology Department, Government of Jammu and Kashmir. The points are:-

- i. Efforts should be made to fell minimum number of trees and in any case not more than **840** trees only shall be felled. Any felling shall only be done under the strict supervision of State Forest Department after issuance of felling permission from concerned DFO and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
- ii. The UT Govt shall upload the KML files of the degraded forest area accepted for raising compensatory afforestation as well as the forest area proposed for diversion in the extant proposal in the E-Green watch portal of the Forest Survey of India.
- iii. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- iv. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
- v. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department, or person without approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.
- vi. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- vii. Sufficient firewood, preferably by the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- viii. The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- ix. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- x. The User Agency shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased by the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court.


- xi.** The User agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.
- xii.** No muck shall be dumped in the forest land in context of the undertaking given by User Agency.
- xiii.** The User Agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road as per IRC norms.
- xiv.** Speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Forest Areas.
- xv.** Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per provision under 1.21 of the Handbook of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and Forest Conservation Rules, 2003 (Guideline & Clarification), 2019, MoEF&CC.
- xvi.** Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests and wildlife.
- xvii.** The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change may revoke/suspend the clearance, if implementation of any of the above conditions is not satisfactory. The State government will ensure compliance of these conditions through Forest Department.

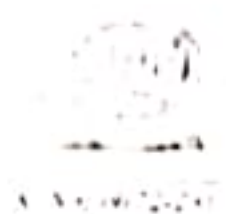

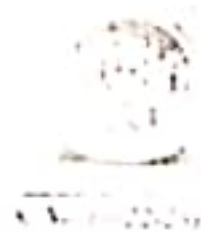


