

(B) Conditions which need to be strictly complied on field after handing over of forest land to the user agency by the J&K Forest Department but the compliance in form of undertaking shall be submitted prior to Stage-II approval:

Undertaking

I, Executive Engineer, PWD (R&B) Division Poonch, do hereby undertake to comply the following conditions:

- i) Legal status of the forest land will remain unchanged.
- Efforts should be made to fell minimum number of trees. The trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the UT Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with UT Forest Department/J&K FDC as applicable.
 - iii) The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government;
 - iv) The user agency shall carry out disposal at pre-designated sites as per the approved scheme.
 - v) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal;
 - vi) The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.
 - vii) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land;
 - Viii) Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the UT Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel;
 - ix) The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
 - No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work;
 - xi) The user agency shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased by the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

- xii) The User Agency shall ensure compliance of all the Court orders, provisions, rules, regulations and guidelines for the time being in force as applicable to the project.
- xiii) The User Agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road as per IRC norms.
- xiv) Speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Forest areas.
- XV) Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per law.
- xvi) Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.

In compliance to the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MOEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 03rd August 2009 wherein the MOEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA, for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MOEF's letter dated 5th Feb 2013 wherein MOEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 0.33 hectares of Forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Public Work Department (R&B) for construction of Road from Sangiote Road 3rd Km to Mohalla Hattian W.No. 6 via Katnarian Qureshian W.No. 4 to Purana School Kallar falls within the Jurisdiction of Tehsil Mendhar.

It is further certified that:-

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under FRA has been carried out for the entire 0.33 hectares of Forest area propose for diversion. As per MOEF letter No.F.No.11-9/98-FC (pt), dated: 5th Feb 2013 for linear projects like construction of roads, there is no requirement of resolution (meeting/consent) of Gram Sabha of that area for forest land use of which is proposed to be diverted. Hence, no such records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee (s), Gram Sabha (s), Sub-Division Level Committee (s) and District Level Committee are enclosed.
- (b) Tehsildar Mendhar vide his No. Teh/Mdr/OQ/624 dated 06-10-2023 and has reported that Forest land is involved in the alignment of said Road and there will be no loss to the rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities under Forest Right Act.
- (c) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under Section 3(2) of the FRA has been completed and the Gram Sabha (s) have given their consent to it. Not Applicable.





- Conditions which need to be strictly complied on field after handing over of (B) forest land to the user agency by the J&K Forest Department but the compliance in form of undertaking shall be submitted prior to Stage-II approval:

Legal status of the forest land will remain unchanged. i)

Efforts should be made to fell minimum number of trees. The trees shall be felled under ii) the strict supervision of the UT Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with UT Forest Department/J&K FDC as applicable.

The KML files of the area to be diverted, area accepted for raising CA, proposed iii) SMC works, the proposed Catchment Area Treatment area and the WLMP area shall be uploaded on the e-Green watch portal with all requisite details before issuing working permission towards linear projects or submitting compliance report for seeking Stage-II approval, as the case may be.

Compensatory afforestation will be carried out over Degraded Forest land (DFL) iv) upon 0.66 ha of land in Comp No. 153/M Range Mendhar in Poonch Forest Division as per proposed CA scheme. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.

The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of V) Central Government:

The user agency shall carry out disposal at pre-designated sites as per the vi) approved scheme.

The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the vii) project proposal;

The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be viii) transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.

No labour camp shall be established on the forest land; ix)

Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User x) Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the UT Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel;

The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.

No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for

xi)

transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work;

xiii) The user agency shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased by the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

xiv) The User Agency shall ensure compliance of all the Court orders, provisions, rules, regulations and guidelines for the time being in force as applicable to the project.

xv) The User Agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of

the road as per IRC norms.

- xvi) Speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Forest areas.
- vii) Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per law.
- xviii) Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
- 3 User Agency shall obtain Environment Clearance or any other clearance, if applicable under any act/rule/order/guideline etc for the proposal.
- 4. After receipt of the compliance report on fulfillment of the conditions under para-2, above, final approval order shall be given under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 followed by sanction order. The use of forest land will not be allowed till final approval is accorded.
