



JUSTIFICATION LETTER FOR DIVERSION OF FOREST LAND

1. Border Roads Organisation is a department under Ministry of Defence, Government of India. The road Budhal-Mahore-Gul is a part of 31 BRTF under Sampark project, BRO. The road is under improvement to NHDL specifications through EPC mode. Now, the DPRs for package-I, package-II, package-III & package-IV are under process of approval at ministry. Road alignment is passing along forest area. Hence, the forest land diversion is being prepared under Rajouri, Dharmadi and Ramban forest divisions. The project districts are Rajouri, Reasi and Ramban in the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir. The districts Rajouri, Reasi and Ramban are bounded by Shopian district in North, Poonchh in West, Jammu in south and Udhampur in east. This road is being used by Army for logistic movement in the area. The forest land is required to be diverted for improvement of this road from class-9 to NHDL specifications.

2. Hence, the diversion of forest land is only choice to improve this road under the Ministry of Defence.

Plan related to Engineering Measures for Stabilisation of Muck Dumping Sites in Forest Area

Typical Estimate for construction of crated wall to protect dumping sites of surplus muck/Excavated material in Forest Area as per Engineering Measures.

Taking Length of Crated wall=60mtrs

Trench excavation in dense soil for structures = $1 * 60\text{mtr} * 1.4\text{mtr} * 0.6\text{ mtr}$

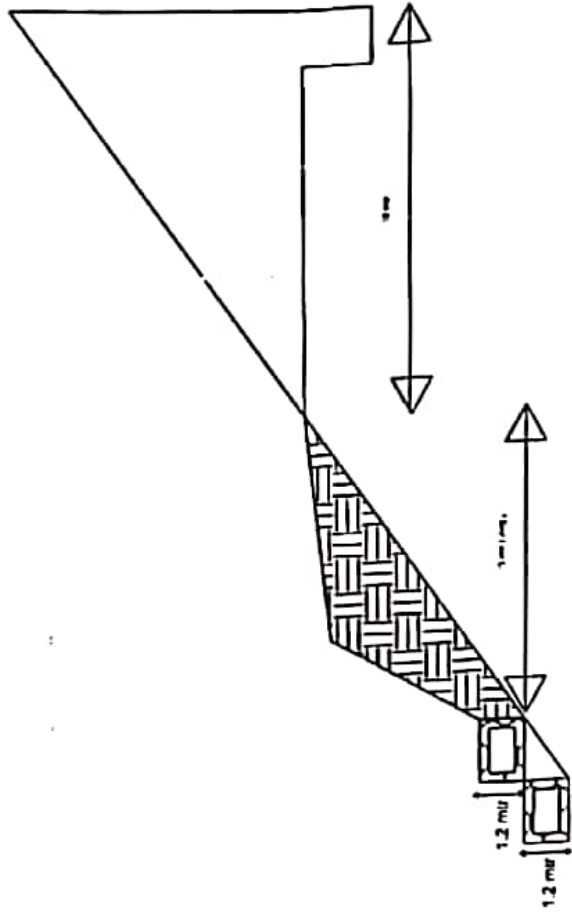
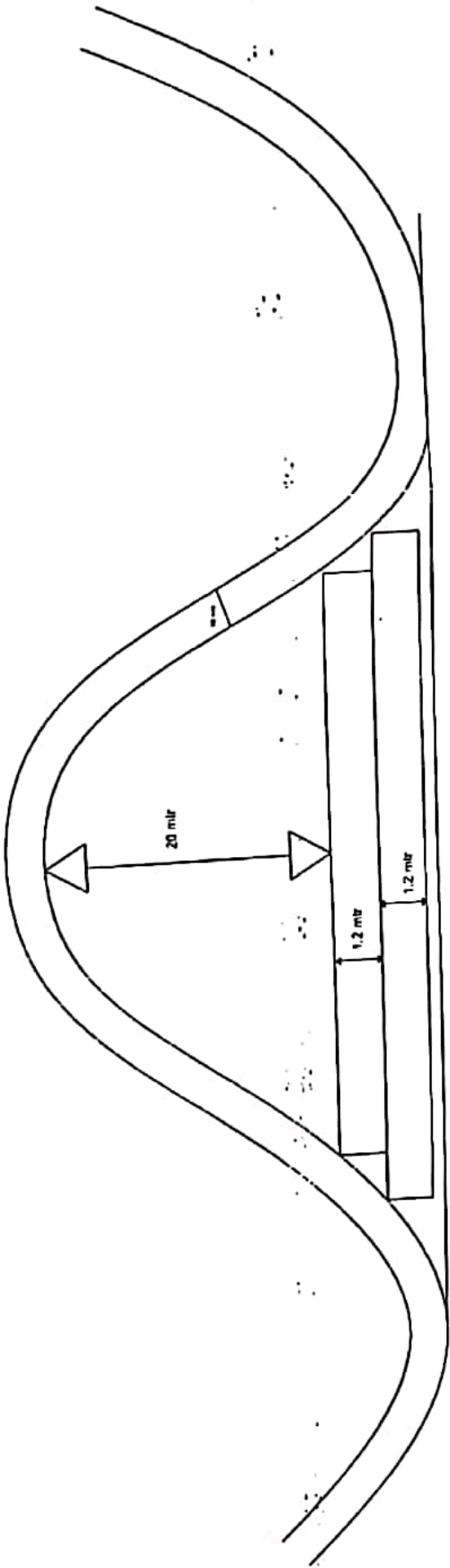



1. The proprietary status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The forest land so diverted shall be utilized only for the purpose for which it has been diverted. It shall not be transferred to any other agency without approval of the Forest Department.
3. The forest land so diverted shall not be mortgaged, reassigned or sub-leased by user agency in any manner what so ever to any other agency.
4. The User Agency shall pay Net Present Value of the forest land to the tune of Rs. 86,47,500/- (Rs. 5. The User Agency shall be bound to pay an amount of Rs. 15,59,886/- (Rs. Fifteen lacs fifty-nine thousand eight hundred eighty-six only) on account of compensation of 1313 trees/poles of different species and dia-classes.
6. The User Agency shall pay Rs. 5,75,000/- (Rs. Five lacs seventy-five thousand only) on account of compensatory afforestation to be carried over 23.06 ha.
7. The extraction of trees shall be done by the SFC/Forest Department on the basis of marking list approved by Conservator of Forests, Working Plan Circle.
8. Any damage done to the forest by the user agency or its employees and contractors or people employed by them shall be charged from the user agency at the rate of ten times the standard rate of 1992.
9. The user agency shall construct complete retaining/breast walls on the both sides of the road/railway line/earth work/tunneling etc., and take other necessary steps, so as to minimize soil erosion/land slips. In this regard, the user agency shall seek technical guidance from Director, Soil Conservation Department, J&K.
10. The forest land so diverted shall return to the Forest Department when it is no longer required by the User Agency without any cost.
11. The user agency shall also pay any other amount which will become payable as per orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court or Government/Forest Department, J&K.
12. The user agency shall submit an undertaking that in case of any upward revision of rates of Net Present Value, the user agency will pay the amount of differential Net Present Value.
13. The mode of payment of compensatory afforestation shall be according to Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA) rules and shall be communicated lateron.

14. The possession of Forest land diverted for non-forestry purpose under the orders of competent authority, should not be handed over to the user agency till all payments due against Compensation of trees, NPV/Compensation of land, Compensatory afforestation costs etc are not deposited with Chief Accounts Officer in the office of the PCCF. Before handing over the possession of the Forest land it should be further ensured that there are no outstanding dues with the said User Agency in respect of the cases sanctioned in the past.
15. In such proposals where heavy soil cutting/felling is likely to be involved, the user agency shall formulate appropriate Soil Conservation Management Plan with the consultation of Soil Conservation Department, J&K Govt. The implementation of the same, alongwith the other terms and conditions put by the Advisory Committee, shall be monitored by a committee of officials comprising of one official from Soil Conservation Department.
16. The user agency should ensure the availability of funds under appropriate heads for making payments due to the Forest Department as per the conditions stipulated in the order of transfer of forest land.
