**Sub: Issuance of Forest Right Act certificate (FRA) for the diversion of 12.052 ha of forest land required for construction of road from Mari to Dhakikote Part II, Package No.JK14-560, Stage I, Phase XI under PMGSY Division Mahore, District Reasi.**

In reference to letter No.11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 of Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's wherein guidelines on submission of evidences have been issued for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain exemption/relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that:-

- The 12.052 hectares of forest land is proposed to be diverted in favour of Construction of road from Mari to Dhakikote Part II, Package No.JK14-560, Stage I, Phase XI under PMGSY Division Mahore, District Reasi.
- Tehsildar Thakrakote vide No. TT/2022-23/N/253 dated 28-03-2023 has communicated that **No recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups (PTG) and Pre Agricultural Communities (PAC) shall be affected in diversion of forest land for non forest use** for construction of road from Mari to Dhakikote Part II, Package No.JK14-560, Stage I, Phase XI under PMGSY Division Mahore, District Reasi.

Hence, Forest Right Act certificate is Issued for forest land measuring **12.052 hectares** required for **construction of road from Mari to Dhakikote Part II, Package No.JK14-560, Stage I, Phase XI under PMGSY Division Mahore, District Reasi.**


