

In compliance with the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA, for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain exemption/relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 6.938 hectares of forest land is proposed to be diverted in favour of PMGSY Division Billawar, in District Kathua. Hence, no such records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s) Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed.

- (d) Joint Inspection of the above said road has been conducted by the user agency, (PMGSY) alongwith concerned Officers/Officials of Forest Department and Revenue Department, as Intimated by Executive Engineer, PMGSY Division, Billawar vide No. EE/PMGSY/B/663-664 dated 26-06-2021. **No recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups (PTG) and Pre Agricultural Committees (PAC) shall be affected in diversion of forest land for non forest use for construction of above mentioned PMGSY road projects in PMGSY Division Billawar.**

Hence, Forest Rights Act certificate is issued for forest land measuring 6.938 hectares required for above mentioned PMGSY roads in PMGSY Division, Billawar.
