

Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & HoFF, J&K Government.**

Executive Engineer, PMGSY, Division Reasi vide No.PMGSY/Udh-II/P/2021-22/1095-1100 dated 17-6-2021 and No.PMGSY/Udh-II/R/2021-22/1408-12 dated 01-7-2021 has requested this office for the issuance of FRA certificate for forest land measuring 17.819 Hactares proposed to be diverted for the below mentioned PMGSY roads.

In compliance with the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC (pl) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain exemption/relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that **17.819 hectares** of forest land is proposed to be diverted in favour of **PMGSY Division Reasi, required for the Construction PMGSY roads/ projects in PMGSY Division Reasi, in district Reasi.** Detail of the road/project is detailed below.

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It is further certified that:

- (a) As per MoEF letter No.F. No. 11-9/98-FC(pt.), Dated: 5th Feb 2013 for linear projects like construction of roads, there is no requirement of resolution (meeting/consent) of Gram Sabha of that area for forest land, use of which is proposed to be diverted. Hence, no such records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed.

Tehsildar Pouni vide No. Teh/P/JA//OQ/240 dated: 02.7.2021 has communicated that no house of primitive tribal group and pre- agricultural land shall be affected under The Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers(Recognition of Forest Rights Act 2006), in case forest land is diverted for proposed non-forest purpose i.e construction of above mentioned PMGSY roads.

Hence, Forest Rights Act certificate is issued for forest land measuring 17.819 hectares required for above mentioned PMGSY roads in PMGSY Division Reasi.
