This is with reference to the above proposal. The point wise compliance report of the conditions of the in-principle approval is given as under:-

iv.	User agency shall deposit/transfer all the funds (Cost of CA, NPV etc) to CAMPA fund of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and climate change through e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in).	The cost of CA and NPV stands deposited on 10-05-2024 to CAMPA fund through e-portal.
v.	User Agency should ensure that the compensatory levies (CA cost, NPV etc.) are deposited through challan generated online on web portal and deposited in appropriate bank only. Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of the Stage-I clearance.	Compensatory levies (CA cost, NPV) deposited through challan generated online on web portal and deposited in appropriate bank.

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UNDERTAKING:

I, Ashok Kesar Executive Engineer, TLMLD-I Janipur Jammu,
do hereby undertake to comply the following conditions:

- i. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- ii. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
- iii. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department, or person without approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.
- iv. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- v. The maximum width of "Right of Way" for the proposed transmission line will be 35 meters on forest land.
- vi. Clearance shall be allowed in a strip of 3.0 m wide for installation of tension stringing equipment under each conductor.
- vii. The distance between the conductor and the trees should be at least 4.6 m. The inclination and sag of the conductors shall be taken into consideration. Whenever it is necessary to maintain the drainage of electricity, the work of pruning of trees will be done with the permission of the local forest officer.
- viii. The user agency shall install circuit breakers at appropriate places in addition to necessary ground clearance to protect wild animals from electrocution.
- ix. The user agency at its cost shall provide bird deflectors, which are to be fixed on upper conductor of transmission line at suitable intervals to avoid bird hits.
- x. The User Agency shall comply with the guidelines for laying transmission lines through forest areas issued by Ministry vide letter no. 7-25/2012-FC dated 05/05/2014 & 19/11/2014.
- xi. User agency in consultation with the State Forest Department, shall prepare a detailed scheme for creation and maintenance of plantation of dwarf species (preferably medicinal plants) in the Right of Way under the transmission line, and provide funds for execution of the said scheme to the State Forest Department.
- xii. Sufficient firewood, preferably by the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- xiii. The User agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.

- xiv. No muck shall be dumped in the forest land in context of the undertaking given by User Agency.
- xv. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per provision under 1.21 of the Handbook of Forest (conservation) Act, 1980 and Forest Conservation Rules, 2003 (Guideline & Clarification), 2019, MoEF&CC.
- xvi. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests and wildlife.
- xvii. The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change may revoke/suspend the clearance, if implementation of any of the above conditions is not satisfactory. The State government will ensure compliance of these conditions through Forest Department.

In compliance with the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-Fc (pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 (FRA, for short) on the Forest land proposed to be diverted for Non Forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th January 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain exemption/relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 11.2525 hectares of Forest land to JKPTCL Jammu in District Jammu. 
The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 11.2525 hectares of forest area proposed for diversion, As per MoEF letter No. F.No. 11-9/98-FC(9pt). dated 5th Feb. 2013 for

linear projects like constructions of Transmission Line, there is no requirement of resolution meeting / consent of Gram Sabha of area for forest land, use of which is proposed to be diverted. Hence, no such records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed.

Joint inspection of the above said Transmission Line has been conducted by the user agency, (JKPTCL) alongwith concerned Officers / Officials of Forest Department, Block Nagrota/ Ban, Jammu.

No recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups (PTG) and Pre Agricultural Committees (PAC) shall be affected in diversion of forest land for non forest use for construction of above mentioned LILO of 220 KV Udhampur-Gladni Transmission Line.

Hence, Forest Rights Act certificate is issued for forest land measuring 11.2525 hectares required for above mentioned LILO of 220 KV Udhampur-Gladni Transmission Line at Nagrota GSS.
