In compliance of the Rule 6(3)(e) of the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2003 as amended vide the Forest (Conservation) Amendment Rules 2014; Forest (Conservation) second Amendment Rules 2016, it is certified that of 1.45 Hectare of Forest land (kind of soil of which is Gair Mumkin Jangal) is proposed to be diverted in favour of Executive Engineer Transmission Line Maintt. 

On the subject matter cited above, compliance report of the terms and conditions laid down in the above Govt. File No. 9-JKB-026/2023-Jammu dated 24-08-2022 for diversion of 1.45 Ha. of forest land under Forest Conservation Act, 1980 is submitted as under:

- A. Condition which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the Forest Department to the JKPTCL (PDD) TLMD-VIII, Jammu (User Agency).

i)	Legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged	Agreed and complied with

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


Undertaking

It is to certify that I/ We Executive Engineer, TLMD-VIII, JKPTCL Jammu have applied for diversion of 1.45 Ha. of forest land for the purpose of "Stabilization of existing 220 KV S/C Gladni-Udhampur Transmission Line along with realignment on double circuit towers from loc no. 158 upto grid station Udhampur under JKPTCL(PDD), UT of Jammu & Kashmir (online proposal no.FP/JK/TRANS/155098/2022)". I hereby undertake to comply the following conditions:

1. The number of trees/plants to be cut shall not in any way exceed the number shown in the proposal and no harm shall be done to the wildlife during felling of trees.
2. Pertains to forest department
3. Pertains to forest department
4. Pertains to forest department
5. Pertains to forest department
6. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than the specified in the project proposal
7. The user agency shall pay additional amount of NPV as and when increased on the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court and the UT government will ensure that the increased amount is deposited.
8. The permission will be given to this proposal for 99 years, after that permission shall be obtained from the government of India. The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less.
9. No damage will be done to the adjoining forest land. Simultaneously, all efforts will be made to save adjoining forest and forest land.
10. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without approval of the Central Government.
11. The Layout plan shall not be changed by the User Agency without prior approval of the Government
12. The user agency shall comply with the guidelines for laying transmission lines through forest areas issued by ministry vide letter no. 7-25/2012-FC Dated:05.05.2014 & 19.11.2014.
13. The user agency in consultation with the state forest department shall prepare detailed scheme for creation and maintenance of dwarf species (preferably medicinal plants) in the right of way under the transmission line and provide funds for execution of the said scheme to the state forest department
14. Muck dumping if required shall be done only in the permitted designate dumping sites.
15. Any other condition may be stipulated by the regional office from time to time in the

- interest of conservation, protection and development of forest and wildlife.
16. The user agency shall obtain environmental clearance as per the provision of the environmental (protection) act 1986 if applicable.
 17. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of forest(conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC, guideline 1.21 of handbook of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and Forest Conservation Rules, 2003 (Guidelines and Clarification), 2019.
 18. The UT government/User Agency shall take responsibility to obtain all other prior approval/clearances under all other relevant Acts/ Rules/ Court's Rulings/instructions etc., including environmental clearance, as applicable to this proposal.


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

Undertaking

It is to certify that I/ We Executive Engineer, TLMD-VIII, JKPTCL, Jammu have applied for diversion of **1.45 Ha.** of forest land for the purpose of "Stabilization of existing 220 KV S/C Gladni-Udhampur Transmission Line along with realignment on double circuit towers from loc no. 158 upto grid station Udhampur under JKPTCL(PDD), UT of Jammu & Kashmir". I hereby undertake to comply the following conditions:

1. The User Agency shall provide the alignment plan to the DFO/DM, FDC concerned for facilitating felling of trees.
2. Alignment plan shall not be changed by the User Agency without prior approval of the Government.
3. The User Agency shall carry out soil conservation measure to avoid soil erosion during execution of the work.
4. The User Agency shall construct retaining walls/breast walls on forest land, wherever required, and take all necessary steps to check soil erosion which may result due to proposed construction.
5. The extracted muck will not be dumped in forest land.
6. The User Agency shall not violate the provisions of FCA 1980 in the garb of work permission obtained. If violation found, Stage-II shall not be accorded by the Government.
7. The forest land shall be utilized only for the purposes for which it has been indented.
8. The proprietary and legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
9. The forest land shall not be mortgaged, re-assigned, leased or sub-leased by user Agency, in any manner whatever to any agency.
10. No damage will be done to the adjoining forest land.
11. Any damage done to the forest land by the User Agency or its contractors shall be charged from user Agency @10 times as per revised standard rate of 2018 issued vide Government Order No. 10-FST of 2018 dated 09.01.2018.
12. No labour camp/structure for machinery shall be established in the forest land.
13. The working permission is temporary and shall be revoked at any time by the Government.
14. The validity of the working permission is strictly for one year only.
