(revised from 0.602 ha) of forest land in Sy.No. Poramboke and 81, Kabeerabad village, Sy.No. 328, Anaduru village, Sy.No. 58/1, Byalahalli village, Humnabad, Bidar and Bhalki Taluks, Bidar District for 203mm, 152mm, 101mm diameter steel gas pipeline from Reliance Gas Transmission Infrastructure Limited Terminal CVS-05 at Jalsingi along NH-50 within Right of Way (RoW) to Bidar in favour of M/s. Bharat Gas Resources Ltd, 5th Floor, The IL&FS Centre, Plot C-22, G-Block, Bandra Kurla Complex (E), Mumbai (Secondary User Agency) from the already diverted forest land of National Highway Authority of India (Primary User Agency) -reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the State Government's letter No. FEE 10 FLL 2022 (e) dated 19/02/2022 and 04/04/2022 seeking prior approval of the Central Government under Section '2' of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for the above project.

After careful examination of the proposal of the State Government, in-principle approval /Stage-I clearance of the Central Government is hereby granted for re-diversion of 0.5712 ha. of forest land in Sy.No. Poramboke and 81, Kabeerabad village, Sy.No. 328, Anaduru village, Sy.No. 58/1, Byalahalli village, Humnabad, Bidar and Bhalki Taluks, Bidar District for 203mm, 152mm, 101mm diameter steel gas pipeline from Reliance Gas Transmission Infrastructure Limited Terminal CVS-05 at Jalsingi along NH-50 within Right of Way (RoW) to Bidar in favour of M/s. Bharat Gas Resources Ltd, 5th Floor, The IL&FS Centre, Plot C-22, G-Block, Bandra Kurla Complex (E), Mumbai (Secondary User Agency) from the already diverted forest land of National Highway Authority of India (Primary User Agency), subject to the following conditions:-

**A: Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department.**

1. The User Agency shall transfer online, the Net Present Value (NPV) of the forest land being diverted under this proposal, as per the guideline issued by Ministry vide letter No.5-3/2011-FC (Vol-I) dated 06/01/2022. The requisite funds shall be transferred through online portal into CAMPA account of the State Concerned.
2. Funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited in CAMPA account only through e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>). Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of the Stage-I clearance.
3. The KML file of the area re-diverted shall be uploaded on the e-green watch portal with all requisite details and same shall be submitted along with compliance report.
4. The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>).
5. The State Government shall complete settlement of rights, in term of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006, if any, on the forest land to be diverted and submit the documentary evidence as prescribed by this Ministry in it's letter No. 11-9/1998-FC dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 read with 05.07.2013 with necessary enclosures, in support thereof.
6. The boundary of the re-diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost as per the directions of concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
7. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed in para 1.21 of Chapter 1 of the Handbook of comprehensive guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as issued by this Ministry's letter No. 5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.

**B: Conditions which need to be strictly complied on field after handing over of forest land to the user agency by the State Forest Department but the compliance in form of undertaking shall be submitted prior to Stage-II approval:**

1. Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. At the time of payment of the Net Present Value (NPV) at the then prevailing rate, the User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
3. The period of re-diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less.
4. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 0.5712 ha.
5. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
6. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
7. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
8. The forest land proposed to be re-diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agency, department or person without prior approval of the Central Government.
9. No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused.
10. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of the Central Government.




- 11.The concerned Divisional Forest Officer, will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in the surrounding area.
- 12.The User Agency shall submit the annual self-compliance report in respect of the above stated conditions to the State Government and Integrated Regional Office, Bangalore by the end of March every year and
- 13.The user agency shall comply all the provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, Hon'ble Court Order (s) and NGT Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.

After receipt of compliance report on fulfilment of the conditions mentioned above, the proposal shall be considered for final approval under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. Working permission, if any issued, shall be intimated to IRO, Bengaluru. Transfer of forest land shall not be affected till final approval is granted by the Central Government in this regard.

Further, it may also be noted that this in-principle approval shall be valid for a period of 5 years from the date of issue of this letter. In the event of non-compliance of the above conditions, this in-principle approval shall be revoked after 5 years.





With reference to the above subject, The Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Bengaluru has accorded stage-I approval for the Re-diversion of 0.5712 hectare of forest land in Sy. No. Poramboke and 81, Kabeerabad Village Sy. No. 328, Anaduru Village, Sy. No. 58/1, Byalahalli Village, Humnabad, Bidar and Bhalki Taluks, bidar District for 203 mm, 152 mm, 101mm diameter steel gas pipeline from Reliance Gas Transmission Infrastructure Limited Terminal CVS-05 at Jalsingi along NH-50 within Right of way (Row) to Bidar in favour of M/s Bharat Gas Resource Limited, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, The IL & FS Centre, lot C-22, G-Block, Bandra Kurla Complex (E), Mumbai [secondary user agency] from the already diverted forest land of National Highway Authority of India [primary user agency] In ref (1) cited above.

As per this office demand notice M/s Bharat Gas Resource Limited, Mubai has remitted Rs. 3,82,794/- towards NPV charges vide Transaction ID : M3597094 on 06.06.2022.

Further, as per the Guidelines dated 08.08.2014 & 27.09.2017 of MoFF & CC, Government of India, New Delhi, which states that, "In case of liner projects of other User



Agencies in-principal approval under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 may be deemed as the working permission for tree cutting and commencement of work, if the required compensatory levies as above, stipulated in the in-principal approval are realized from the User Agency and where necessary, for Compensatory Afforestation, transfer and mutation of non-forest/ revenue forest land in favour of State Forest Department is affected". And also based on the (Form A Part-I) of serial No. A-1 (vi) which states that, shape of the project 'Linear'.

Further, in pursuance of the developments elucidated above and the directions issued by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Head of Forest Force), Bangalore (Vide letter No. KFD/HoFF/A5-4(MISC)/2/2019-FC Dt. 09/16.02.2021) the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Bidar Forest Division has signed "Agreement" with M/s Bharat Gas Resource Limited, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, The IL & FS Centre, lot C-22, G-Block, Bandra Kurla Complex (E), Mumbai (Agreement No. 01/2022-23 Dated: 08.06.2022) over an extent of 0.5712 hectares. In pursuance of the directions given by the Principle Chief Conservator of Forests and on the strength of the Agreement signed, M/s Bharat Gas Resource Limited, Mumbai has been given this working Permission as hereunder;

### ORDER

M/s Bharat Gas Resource Limited, Mumbai, is hereby permitted to use the land for laying of underground Steel Gas Pipeline in over an extent of 0.5712 hectares of forest land from Reliance Gas Transmission Infrastructure Limited Terminal CVS-05 at Jalsingi along NH-50 within Right of way (Row) to Bidar of forest land in Sy. No. Poramboke and 81, Kabeerabad Village Sy. No. 328, Anaduru Village, Sy. No. 58/1, Byalahalli Village, Humnabad, Bidar and Bhalki Taluks, Bidar District for a period one year w.e.f. 08.06.2022, with all terms & conditions which are stipulated in the Forest Lease Agreement Dt. 08.06.2022 Further,

- 1) The Lessee shall carry out work as per the condition mentioned in the Agreement No. 01/2022-23 and as per the conditions stipulated by the Government of India and Government of Karnataka in respective approvals or forest clearances. This working permission shall be cancelled/revoked in case any violations/deviations from the said conditions or violations/deviations from any of the Orders/Guidelines/Directives issued from the Government from time to time.
- 2) The Lessee shall submit all such reports as specified under various provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 from time to time
- 3) No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused.
- 4) The lessee shall not cut trees with-out prior permission of the Forest officers in the diverted area.
- 5) The Lessee shall not deface the forest boundaries, use any area for construction of road, sheds, etc., and shall not operate beyond the limit of the forest land assigned by the Government.



- 6) The construction work should be carried between 6.00 AM to 6.00 PM. (In order to avoid any disturbances to the Wildlife).
- 7) This Working Permission is valid for one year only i.e. from 08.06.2022 to 07.06.2023. The user agency has to obtain Stage-II approval within one year.
- 8) Violation of any of the conditions shall invite penal action as deemed fit by the Karnataka Forest Department.
- 9) This Working permission order is only to take up the laying of underground Steel Gas pipeline and not to use this pipeline to supply of gas before Stage-II approval.
