Abstract:- Electrification work of Kayattuva- Thodakkayam area under Electrical Section, No.1 Kothamangalam- obtaining Forest clearance- submitting the report on admittance of certain clauses in G.O.(Rt)No.414/2021/F&WLD Dated, Thiruvananthapuram, 16/12/2021 of Forest & Wildlife (C) Department, Government of Kerala.




In compliances of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC(pt) dated 3 rd August, 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoFE issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 0.006 hectare of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Kerala State Electricity Board Limited for Electrification of Kayattuva-Thodakkayam area in Ernakulam district falls within the jurisdiction of Kombanad Village in Kunnathunad tehsil.

It is further certified that:

- a) the complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for entire hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultation and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexuretoannexre
- b) the diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama sabha have given their consent to it;
- c) the proposal does not involve recognized right of primitive Tribal Groups and pre-agriculatural communities.
