

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter no 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Schedule Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that **78.072 hectares** of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of National Highways & Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL) for "**Widening and improvement of Package-2 of Maram-Peren Road Section of NH-129A into two laning of existing 40.890 km from Willong khullen village to Ziumi village of 74.800 km in the state of Manipur on EPC mode by NHIDCL**" in the **Senapati district** falls within the jurisdiction of Pumdumlong (Pumalong), Yangkhullen, Bendramei, Bakie (Yangkhunou), Willong Khullen, Kamalung and Ziumi village in Willong Sub-division.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire **78.072 hectares** of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of consultations and meeting of the Forest Right Committee, Gram Sabha are enclosed as annexure I.
- (b) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabha have given their consent to it.
- (c) The villages namely Pumdumlong (Pumalong), Willong Khullen and Kamalung are involves recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and their consent has been obtained after due consultation with the affected community. However, Yangkhullen, Bendramai, Kakie (Yangkhunou) and Ziumi does not involve recognised right of primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agriculture Community.



MINUTES OF MEETING IN CONNECTION WITH CONSTRUCTION (WIDENING/TWO LANING WITH PAVED SHOULDER) OF NH-129 (A) MARAM-PEREN ROAD HELD ON 30-01-2021 AT 01.30 PM IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF DC OFFICE SENAPATI WITH SHRI TH. KIRANKUMAR, IAS, DEPUTY COMMISSIONER/CALA, SENAPATI IN THE CHAIR.

Members present in the meeting is at Annexure.

At the outset, the Deputy Commissioner welcomed all members present for the meeting.

1. The Additional Deputy Commissioner, Senapati highlighted the importance of the project which is being taken up by NHIDCL and also briefed about the land acquisition process which is in progress under The National Highways Act, 1956.
2. The Deputy Commissioner/CALA, Senapati District initiated the discussion about issues pertaining to the Maram Tribe which is recognized as one of the Primitive Tribal Groups (now called Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups) by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India. Since the proposed road in question will pass through many villages of Maram Tribe, input/suggestions for protection of their cultural identity, monuments, habitation, forests, etc. were deliberated upon. The views of other villages and their concerns were also recorded and detailed discussion was held.
3. The members from different villages highlighted the following issue of their concern:
 - a. Shri Shakpa, Secretary of Maram Makha Sagai village pointed out that there is a culturally significant stone monument between 3 and 4 Km of the proposed road which is likely to be affected. As per their tradition, a purification ritual has to be carried out in case the stone is removed or affected.
 - b. Shri Ngouning Scaria, Chairman of Sangkhumai Village pointed out that a stone located at 30 km is a stone monument for their community which cannot be removed and request for a minor diversion of the proposed road to protect the same.
 - c. Shri Lucas, Secretary of Sangkunglung Village, pointed out that when the existing Maram-Peren road was constructed a few years back, debris from the slope-cutting damaged certain stone monuments of their village below the road and requested to take due care for their culturally significant sites/monuments/stones when the present project is implemented in due course of time.
 - d. It was also pointed out that a Golden Jubilee stone below the helipad at Maram Centre and resting sites constructed with stones and boulders numbering around 10 (Ten) locations in Willong area along the present road may be protected.
 - e. Shri L. T. Hoi of Yang Khullen Village highlighted that due diligence in assessment of damaged/affected properties and timely payment of compensation matters will go a long way in safeguarding the concerns of the villagers and also facilitate timely completion of the project.

- f. It was also pointed out that between 55 and 61 km, during the construction of the existing road a few years back, earth cutting on the hill slope had damaged a number of houses and properties of Zenamci Village which is located right below the road. Therefore, due care must be taken to prevent such incidents as it poses a threat to the lives and properties of the villages of Zenamci.
4. After due deliberation of all views and suggestions from the members present, the Deputy Commissioner/CALA Senapati assured that due care and consideration, subject to verification, will be taken for the Maram Tribe which is a Primitive Tribal Group as well as other communities and villages where the road will pass through. Further, an enquiry will be carried out for the areas of concern raised in the meeting by the concerned Sub-Divisional Officers to ensure proper identification of locations and feasibility of taking appropriate measures to safeguard the interests of the affected parties and settle the matter in consultation with the Villages. Due care during execution of the project to safeguard and respect the sentiments of the people as well as safety of the people and their property as the terrain is very steep to be taken by the implementing agencies.
5. The Deputy commissioner/CALA, Senapati further stated that compensation matters will be taken up in consultation with the Government as per rules in due course of time.
6. It was also decided that in areas where the ownership of land is disputed between different parties and objections raised under Section 3 (1) of National Highways Act, 1956, the interested parties will be given a time of 1 (one) month in which further 2 (two) more rounds of consultation with interested parties will be taken up wherein opportunities will be given to resolve the ownership dispute. Thereafter, if matter is not resolved, the compensation amount for the disputed area would be kept in the account of Deputy Commissioner/CALA and released after the dispute is resolved.

The meeting ended with thanks from the chair.

MINUTES OF MEETING IN CONNECTION WITH CONSTRUCTION (WIDENING/TWO LANING WITH PAVED SHOULDER) OF NH-129 (A) MARAM-PEREN ROAD HELD ON 30-01-2021 AT 01.30 PM IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF DC OFFICE SENAPATI WITH SHRI TH. KIRANKUMAR, IAS, DEPUTY COMMISSIONER/CALA, SENAPATI IN THE CHAIR.

Members present in the meeting is at Annexure.

At the outset, the Deputy Commissioner welcomed all members present for the meeting.

1. The Additional Deputy Commissioner, Senapati highlighted the importance of the project which is being taken up by NHIDCL and also briefed about the land acquisition process which is in progress under The National Highways Act, 1956.
2. The Deputy Commissioner/CALA, Senapati District initiated the discussion about issues pertaining to the Maram Tribe which is recognized as one of the Primitive Tribal Groups (now called Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups) by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India. Since the proposed road in question will pass through many villages of Maram Tribe, input/suggestions for protection of their cultural identity, monuments, habitation, forests, etc. were deliberated upon. The views of other villages and their concerns were also recorded and detailed discussion was held.
3. The members from different villages highlighted the following issue of their concern:
 - a. Shri Shakpa, Secretary of Maram Makha Sagai village pointed out that there is a culturally significant stone monument between 3 and 4 Km of the proposed road which is likely to be affected. As per their tradition, a purification ritual has to be carried out in case the stone is removed or affected.
 - b. Shri Ngouning Scaria, Chairman of Sangkhumai Village pointed out that a stone located at 30 km is a stone monument for their community which cannot be removed and request for a minor diversion of the proposed road to protect the same.
 - c. Shri Lucas, Secretary of Sangkunglung Village, pointed out that when the existing Maram-Peren road was constructed a few years back, debris from the slope-cutting damaged certain stone monuments of their village below the road and requested to take due care for their culturally significant sites/monuments/stones when the present project is implemented in due course of time.
 - d. It was also pointed out that a Golden Jubilee stone below the helipad at Maram Centre and resting sites constructed with stones and boulders numbering around 10 (Ten) locations in Willong area along the present road may be protected.
 - e. Shri L. T. Hoi of Yang Khullen Village highlighted that due diligence in assessment of damaged/affected properties and timely payment of compensation matters will go a long way in safeguarding the concerns of the villagers and also facilitate timely completion of the project.

- f. It was also pointed out that between 55 and 61 km, during the construction of the existing road a few years back, earth cutting on the hill slope had damaged a number of houses and properties of Zenamci Village which is located right below the road. Therefore, due care must be taken to prevent such incidents as it poses a threat to the lives and properties of the villages of Zenamci.
4. After due deliberation of all views and suggestions from the members present, the Deputy Commissioner/CALA Senapati assured that due care and consideration, subject to verification, will be taken for the Maram Tribe which is a Primitive Tribal Group as well as other communities and villages where the road will pass through. Further, an enquiry will be carried out for the areas of concern raised in the meeting by the concerned Sub-Divisional Officers to ensure proper identification of locations and feasibility of taking appropriate measures to safeguard the interests of the affected parties and settle the matter in consultation with the Villages. Due care during execution of the project to safeguard and respect the sentiments of the people as well as safety of the people and their property as the terrain is very steep to be taken by the implementing agencies.
5. The Deputy commissioner/CALA, Senapati further stated that compensation matters will be taken up in consultation with the Government as per rules in due course of time.
6. It was also decided that in areas where the ownership of land is disputed between different parties and objections raised under Section 3 (1) of National Highways Act, 1956, the interested parties will be given a time of 1 (one) month in which further 2 (two) more rounds of consultation with interested parties will be taken up wherein opportunities will be given to resolve the ownership dispute. Thereafter, if matter is not resolved, the compensation amount for the disputed area would be kept in the account of Deputy Commissioner/CALA and released after the dispute is resolved.

The meeting ended with thanks from the chair.
