This refers to letter Nos. F-5/1230/2022/10-11/1917 dated 12/05/2023, 5183 dated 03/12/2023, 1986 dated 08/04/2024 and 3619 dated 10/07/24 of PCCF/ APCCF (LM), Nodal Officer, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

After due consideration of the proposal of the State Government and on the decision of Regional Empowered Committee in its 08 meeting of 2024 on 30/07/2024, the "in-principle" approval of the Central Government, is hereby conveyed for diversion of 176.402 ha (earlier proposed 176.24 ha) Reserved, Protected & Revenue Forest land (34.482 ha in Sidhi & 141.92 ha in Singrauli Forest Division) for construction of new Railway line, Rewa-Sidhi-Singrauli Project in favour of Chief Engineer (Construction), West Central Railway Jabalpur in Sidhi & Singrauli Districts of Madhya Pradesh, we have submitted compliance report as per stage-I clearance given.

A. Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the state forest department

S.no	Conditions	Compliance
1	In view of the guidelines dated 27.12.2023, compensatory afforestation on the equivalent non-forest land is required. Thus, KML file of non-forest land for CA along with the CA scheme, suitability certificate, of non-encumbrances, digital map and the KML file of the area shall be submitted before submitting compliance of in-principle approval. Sub: Proposal for use of 11.94 ha of land from Son Gharial Sanctuary and its ESZ at an approximate distance of 45 km from Sanjay Dubri Tiger Reserve for construction of bridge on Gopad River in connection with Sidhi-Singrauli New B.G. Rail line, Madhya Pradesh-FP/MP/RAIL/6040/2021.

Sir,

Reference is invited to the subject mentioned above. The above proposal was discussed in the 73rd Meeting of Standing Committee of National Board for Wild Life held on 17th July, 2023 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister for Environment, Forest & Climate Change.

2. After discussion, the Standing Committee decided to approve the proposal subject to following conditions:

1. The User Agency should ensure that there is no damage to forest, wildlife and its habitats.
2. No work will be done at night by the User Agency.
3. Fencing with GI wire (jail) on bridge & 500 mtr in length both side of railway track, so that the wildlife and its habitat is not polluted by the travellers.
4. Design (dimensions) of the bridge should be in accordance with WII guidelines on constructing underpasses in tiger landscape. Height of the bridge should be a minimum of 5 m.
5. Care should be taken that no natural drainage gets obstructed during any stage of implementation of the project. Adequate water passageways need to be provided wherever applicable.
6. Construction materials (including top soil) should be procured from outside the sanctuary area or its eco-sensitive zone. The debris should be appropriately dumped outside the sanctuary and its eco sensitive zone by User Agency taking due care of air/dust pollution.
7. No construction material (such as sand, boulder) shall be procured from the

- river bed and no dumping of construction debris or discharge of waste water is done in the river Gopad.
8. The river islands, sandbars and banks will not be disturbed during the nesting season of the resident and migratory birds and aquatic fauna.
 9. The User Agency will not use any other part of the sanctuary which is not included in this project for the movement, transportation and any other purpose of the construction and maintenance of project. User Agency should ensure that no labour is involved in illegal fishing within the sanctuary.
 10. User Agency should attempt that the construction period is kept minimal since construction work continued for a longer duration might completely decimate the wildlife populations in the area beyond recovery.
 11. User Agency, in consultation with the forest department, should construct 12 feet high GI mesh fencing on both sides of the bridge and upto 200 m on both sides of the bridge so as to avoid dumping of garbage in the river and its bank by passengers in trains while passing over the bridge.
 12. Any future maintenance work of the bridge within Sanctuary and its ESZ should be subject to prior approval from the competent authority of Madhya Pradesh Forest Department.
 13. CWLW, Madhya Pradesh should develop appropriate mechanisms to monitor the conditions stipulated herein during various phases of project implementation.
 14. The annual compliance certificate on the stipulated conditions should be submitted by the project proponent to the State Chief Wild Life Warden and an annual compliance certificate shall be submitted by the State Chief Wild Life Warden to the Government of India.
